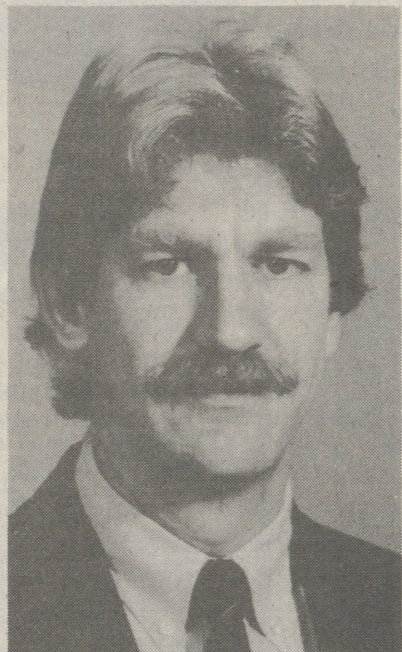
Morgan gives stop-smoking presentation in San Francisco
