Misericordia gallery features Wilkes-Barre native

Vibrant color and clean, geometric shapes are the hallmarks of the art of Wilkes-Barre native Edward Halter Meneeley, whose work will be featured at College Misericordia's Art Gallery in Regina Hall, Dallas, Oct. 8 - Nov. 5.

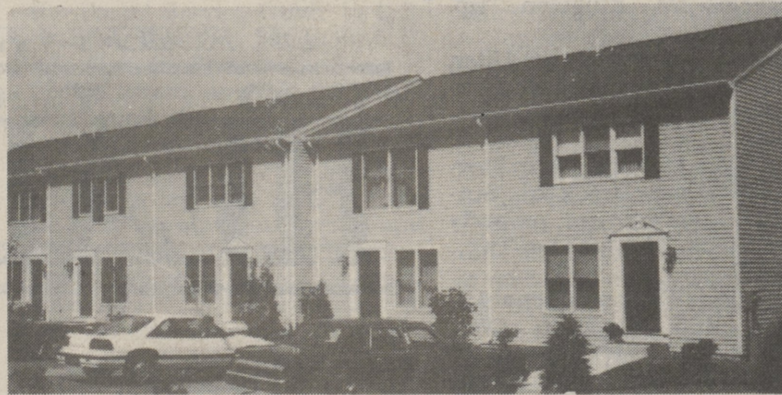
The exhibition, titled "Recent Abstract Expressionistic Painting and Sculpture," includes 40 sculptures and paintings which Meneeley created this decade. They range from the "Window on Yesterday" series, featuring bold slashes of dark color on paper; to "High Low," a highly polished chrome diamond bisected by five chrome tubes.

Meneeley, 63, grew up in Wilkes-Barre and studied there at the Murray Art School, and the School of Visual Arts in New York City. He now maintains a home and studio in a renovated schoolhouse in Weissport, Pa., near Jim Thorpe.

His work is recognized both in the US and Europe, and has been described as structured, yet bursting with playfulness and jubilation; discipline combined with whimsy. He has had solo shows in the Frank Marino and Ericson Galleries in New York City; and has work on display at New York's Metropolitan Museum of Art and Whitney Museum, and the Tate Gallery in London.

Misericordia continues its celebration of 65 years of commitment to the fine arts with a reception for Meneeley on Sunday, Oct. 8, from 2-5 p.m. at The Art Gallery. 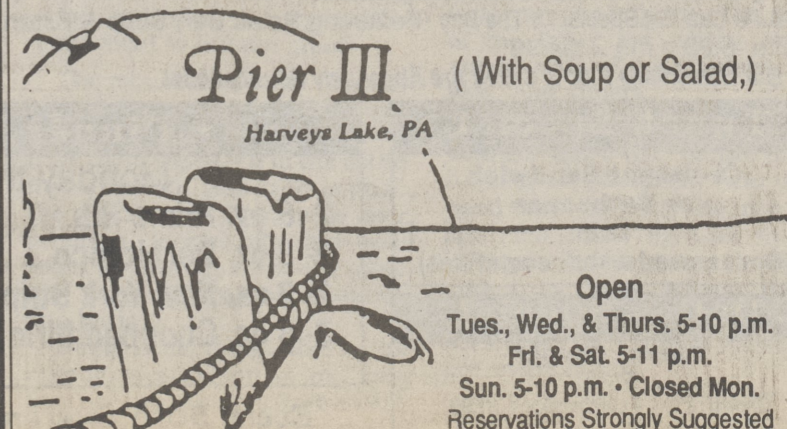

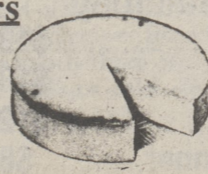
