There is a full line-full service book store including hard cover

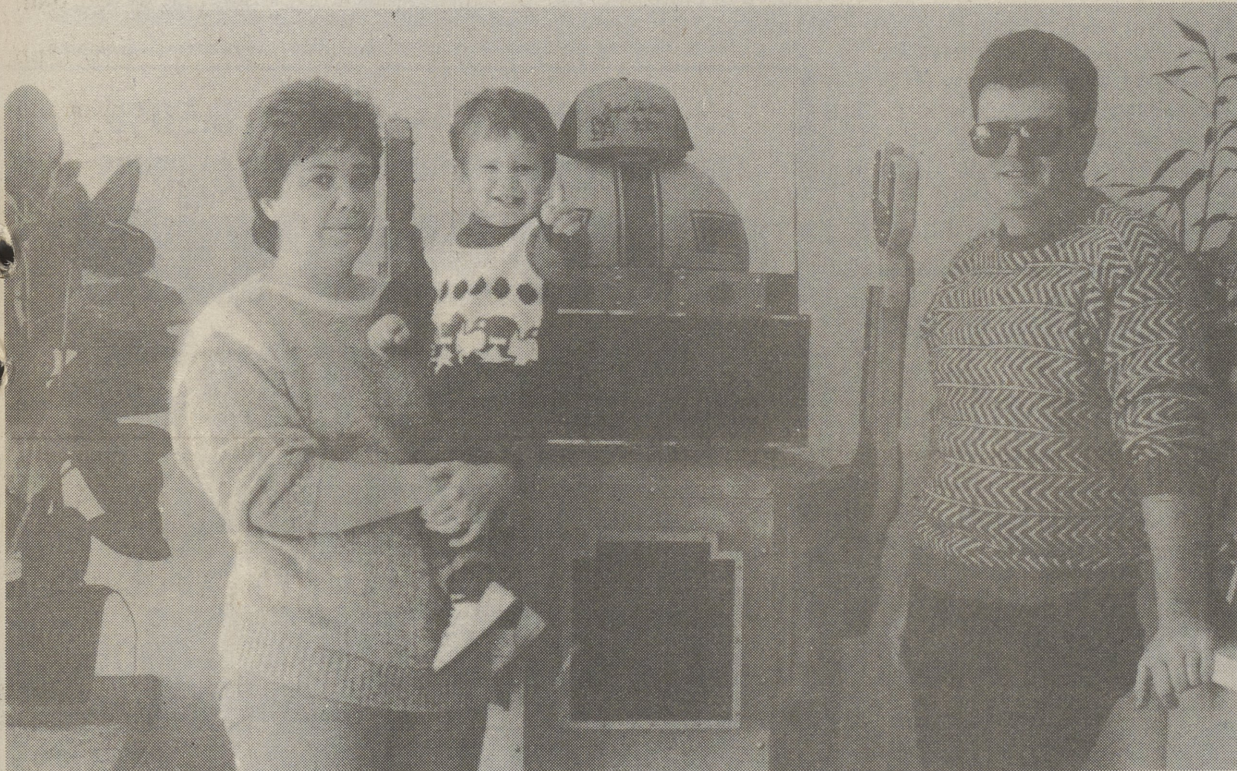
books, paperbacks, magazines and special publications.

Book lovers will find books on sports, crafts, lifestyles, psychology, history, cooking, wines, brides,

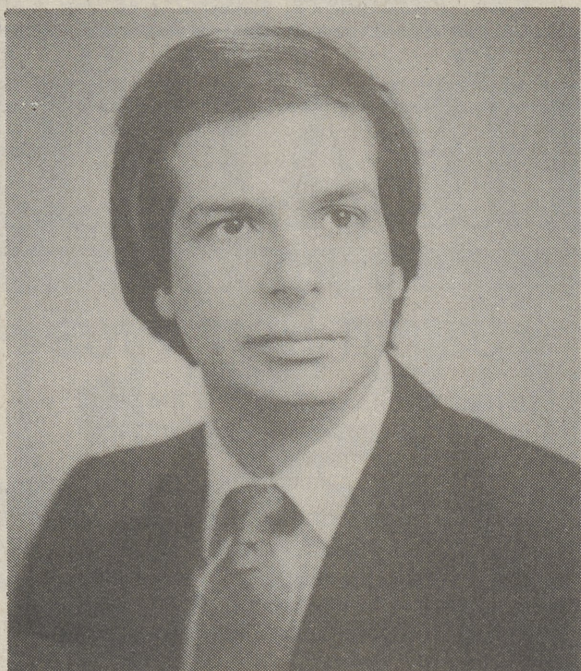
economics, computers, classics and a wide selection of school reference books. The Youells will also do special orders and free gift wrapping.
