New telecourse on math

"For All Practical Purposes," a new telecourse designed by the TeleCollege program at Luzerne County Community College, has been added to the program's Spring list of course offerings.

The new math telecourse, offered as Introduction to Contemporary mathematics, will focus on mathematics as the language of problem solving by exploring math applications in different fields. It will also cover how management science maximizes efficiency and effectiveness when scheduling; how statistics help people understand the world; how geometry enables people to explore and analyze beauty in nature and art; how the development of the computer is historically linked

with math; and other related topics.

The introductory level college math telecourse will be broadcast on WVIA-TV, Channel 44, on Mondays and Wednesdays, January 29 through April 24, from 6 to 6:30 a.m.

LCCC telecourses offer those who are unable to attend scheduled classes the opportunity to earn college credit at home. Telecourses combine television lessons, reading assignments, one or more on-campus discussion sessions, review for exams, or alternate assignments.
