It will also cover how management science maximizes efficiency and effectiveness when scheduling; how statistics help people understand the world; how geometry enables people to explore and analyze beauty in nature and art; how the development of the computer is historically linked with math; and other related topics.

The introductory level college math telecourse will be broad-cast on WVIA-TV, Channel 44, on Mondays and Wednesdays, January 29 through April 24, from 6 to 6:30 a.m.

LCCC telecourses offer those who are unable to attend scheduled classes the opportunity to earn college credit at home. Telecourses combine television lessons, reading assignments, one or more on-campus disussion sessions, review for exams, or alternate assignments.
