

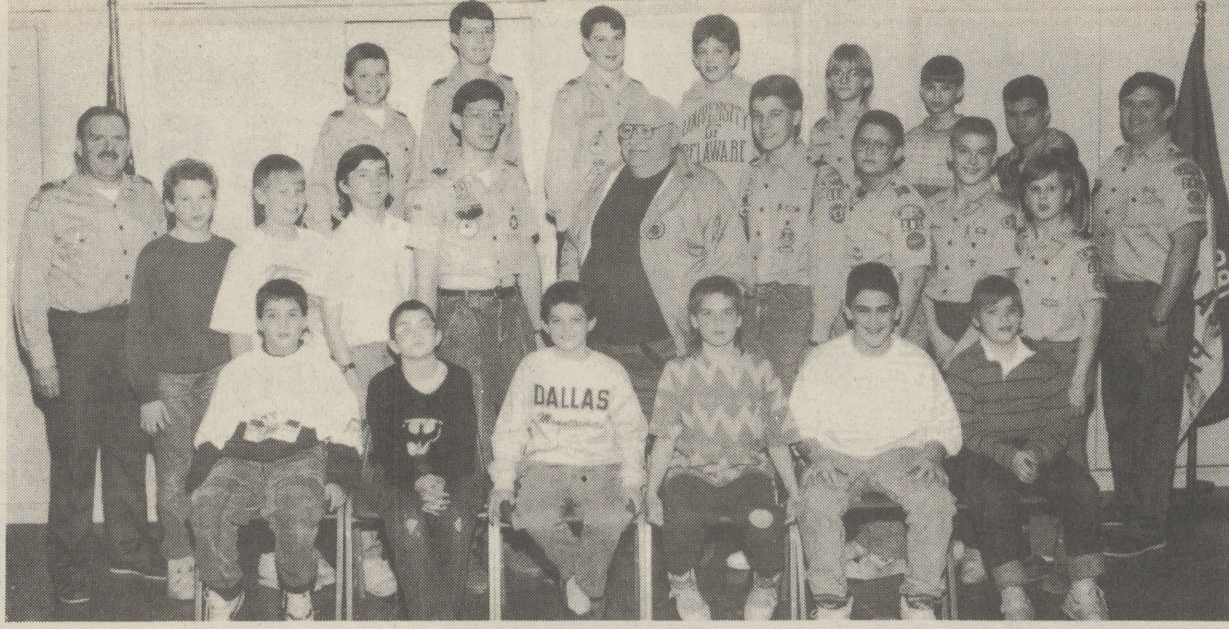

The Clean-up is open to Kingston Township residents only. Kingston Township Police Officers will be on duty to check driver's licenses or other proof of residency.

Items which will not be accepted include washers, dryers, furnaces, stoves, refrigerators, television sets, water heaters, or other large appliances. No tree stumps, concrete, rock, household garbage, or medical waste will be accepted.

Residents are asked to limit themselves to one trip to the dump site.
