YMCA offers variety of camping experiences

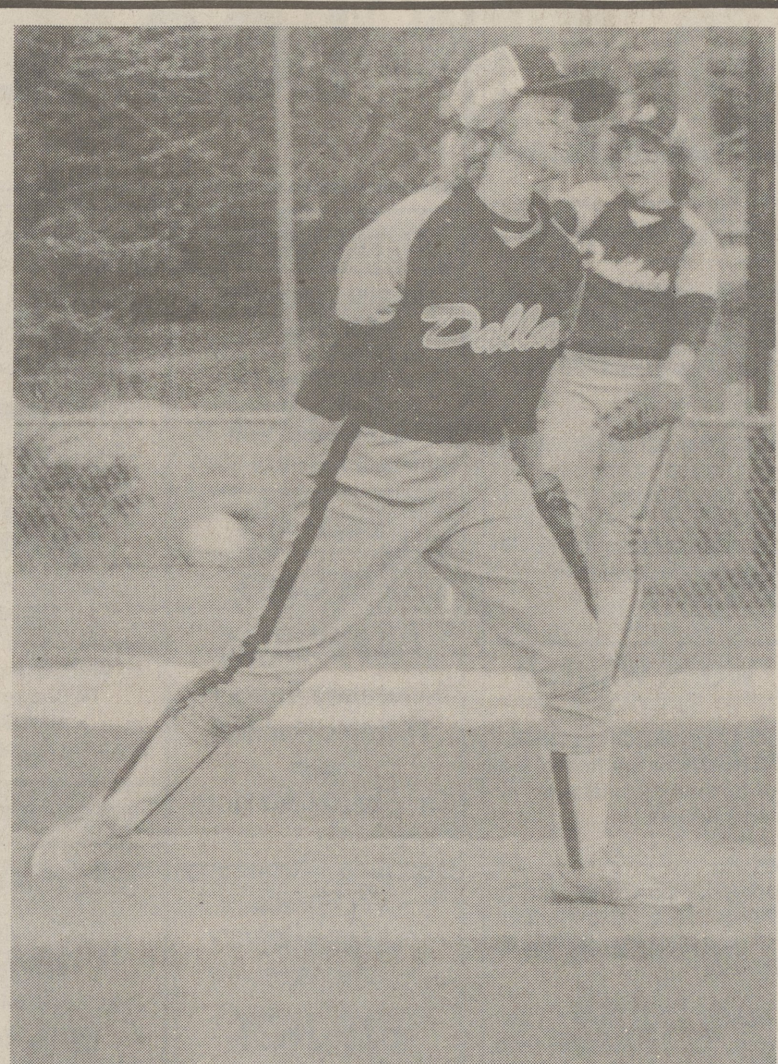

Penn State golf tournament set for June 4 at Mill Race

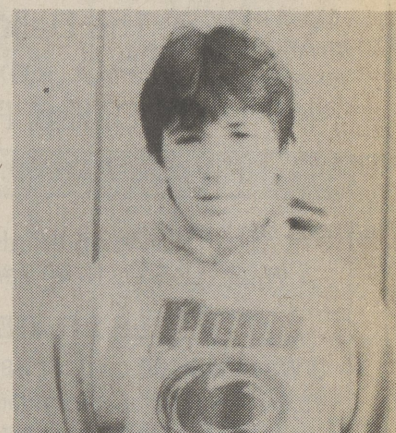
