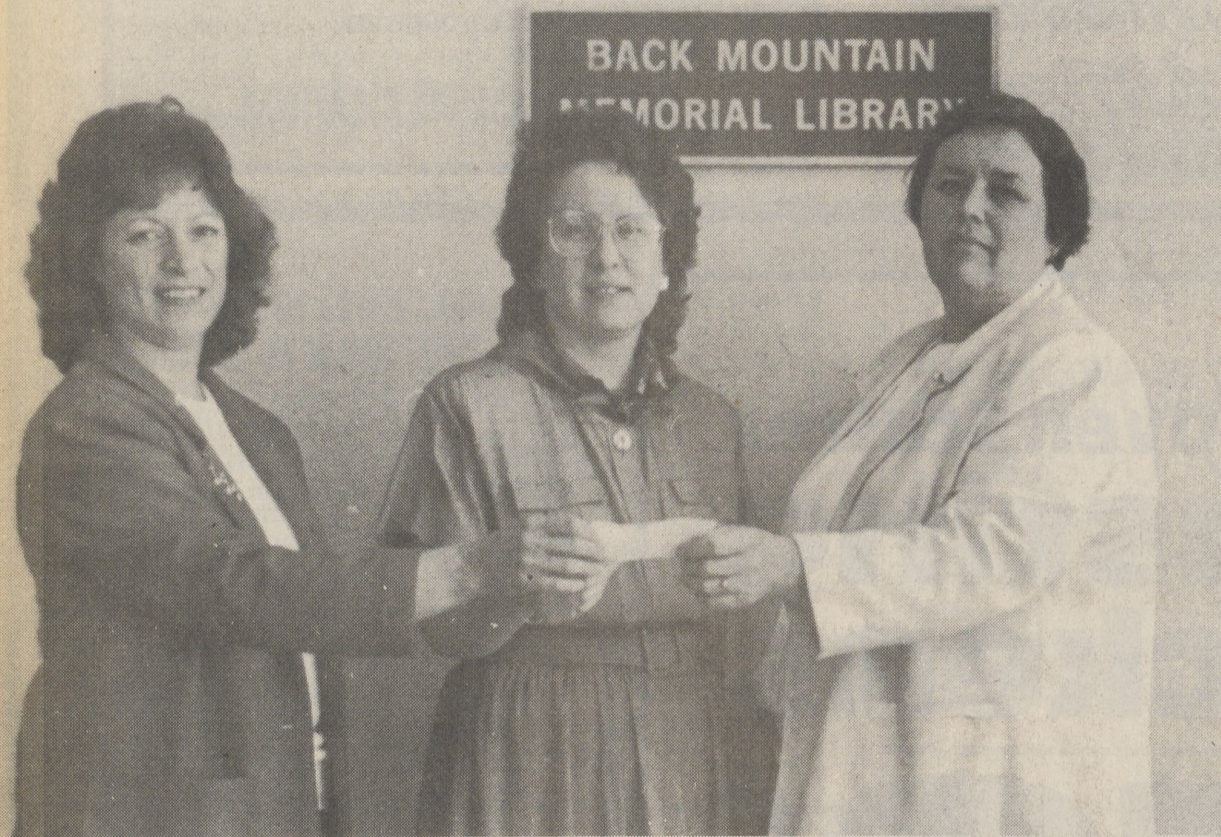
Troop 55 holds hike and cookout

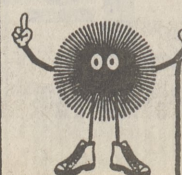
