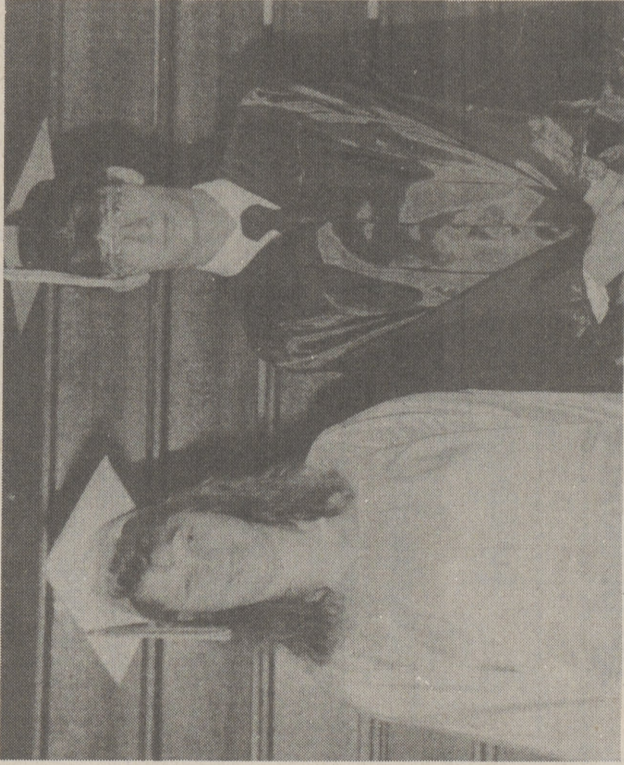

Robyn Pavlick had busy high school years

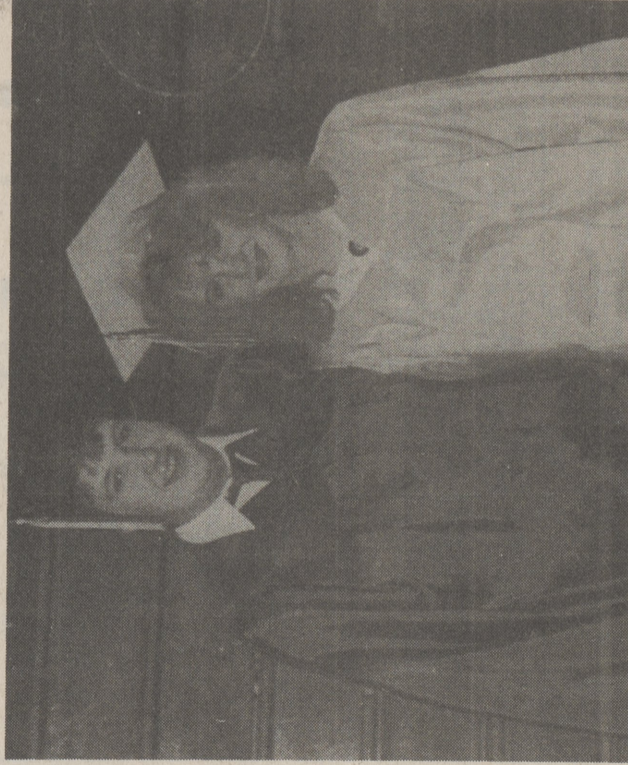
