## Pin-a-fores June 6 results

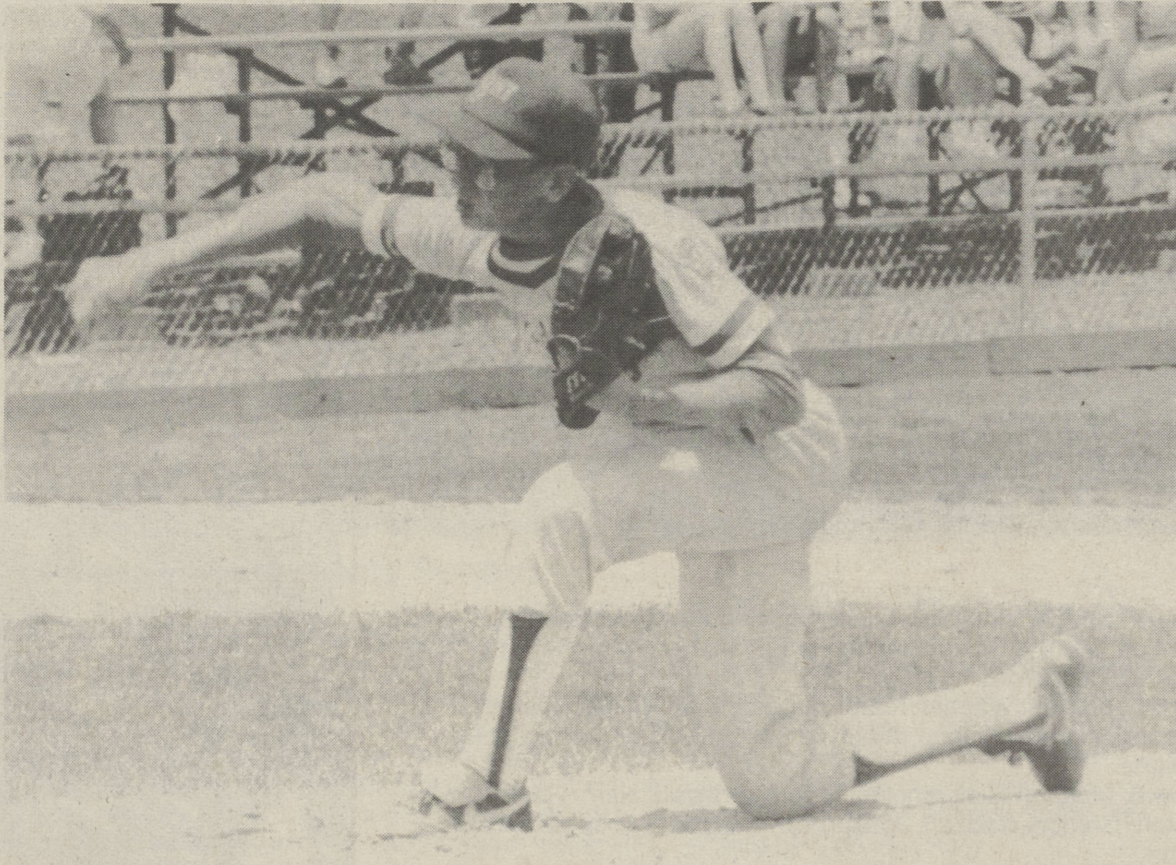

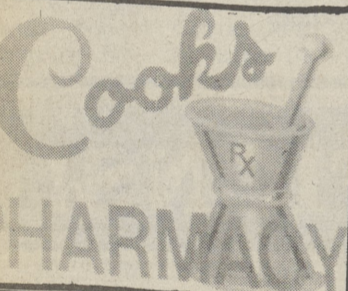
