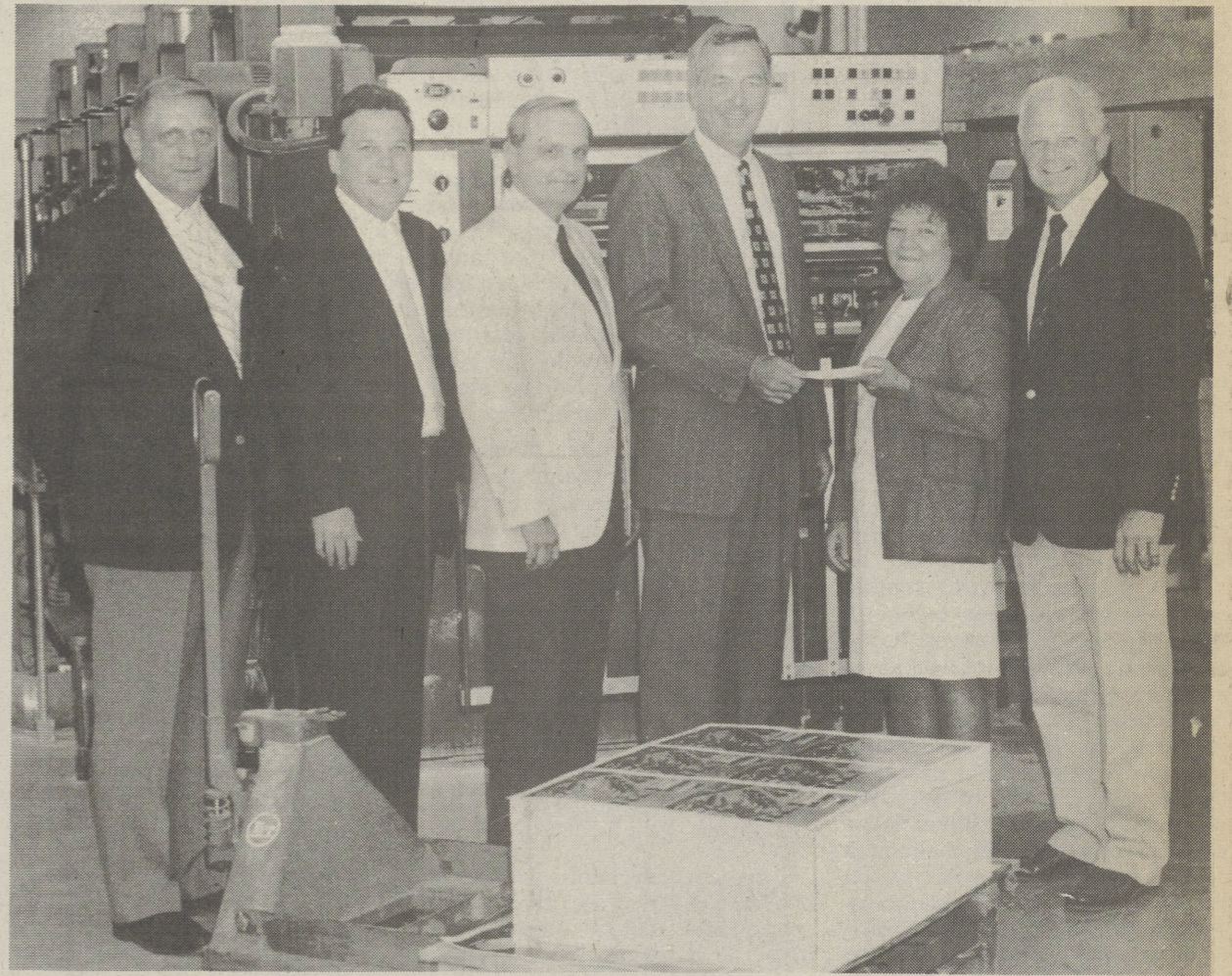
17, 1990. Dylan was born on May 1, 1990 in the Wilkes-Barre General Hospital.
