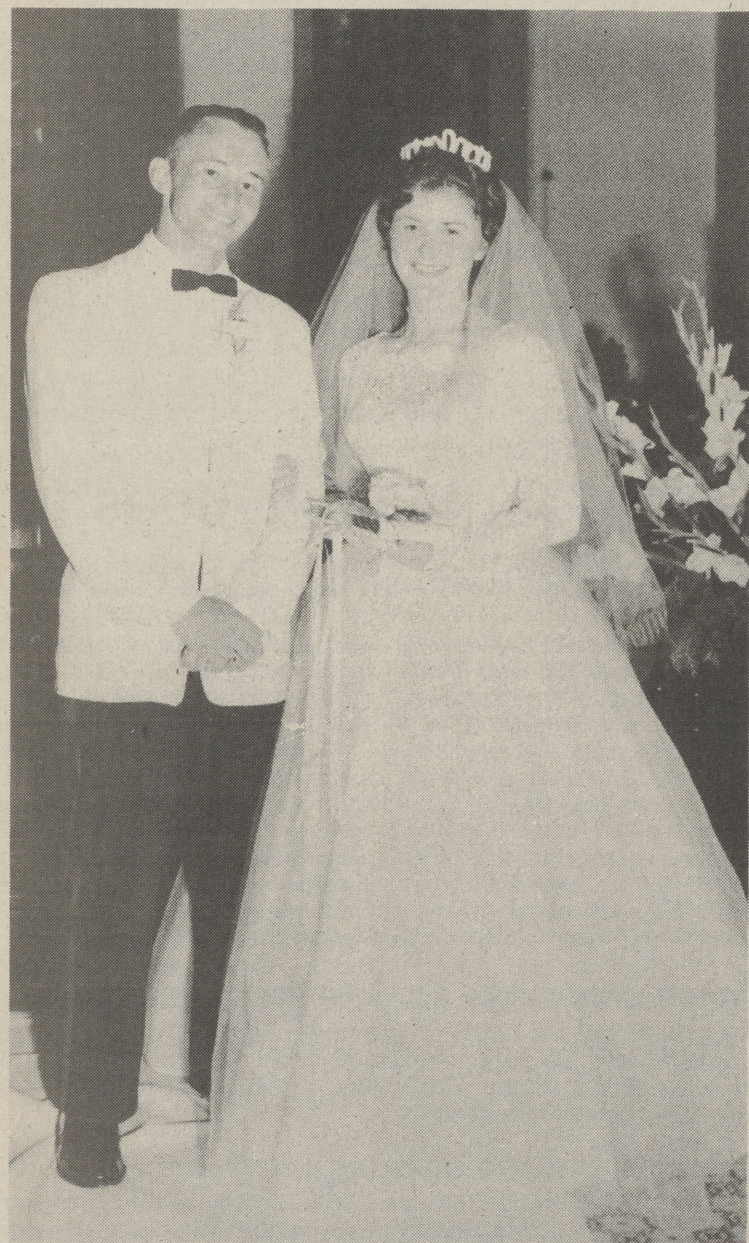

Dog Enforcement agents on the look out for rabies

Eugene Dziak, supervisor, Bureau of Dog Law Enforcement, Pa. Department of Agriculture, Region III, stated that rabies is on the rise in our area and the dog law wardens will be on the prowl in Luzerne and Wyoming Counties.

They will be checking all dogs three months of age and over and all house cats three months of age and older for rabies shots. This is very important to have your animals vaccinated. The dog law wardens will also be checking for

dogs running at large and unlicensed dogs. Anyone in violation of the dog laws will be subject to a fine up to \$300. This does not include costs.

Unannounced drives will be put on for the remainder of the summer.

To protect your children get your current dog license and have your dogs vaccinated. If a dog is licensed we can locate owner.

Dog licenses are sold by your County Treasurer and they are located in your county courthouse.

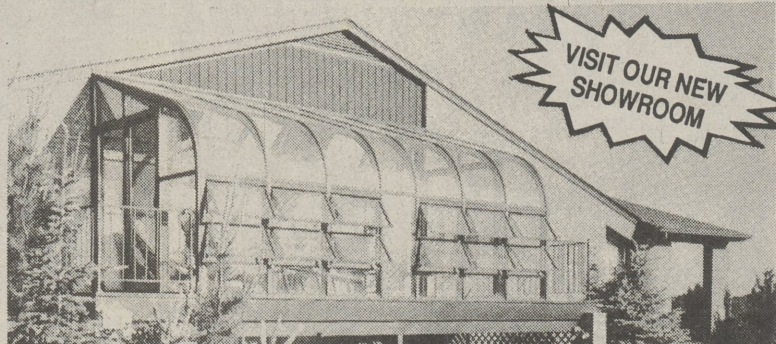
