The Independent Bible Church located on Route 29 near the center of town is presenting Neighborhood Bible Time, a five-day program for children and teens, August 20 through 24.

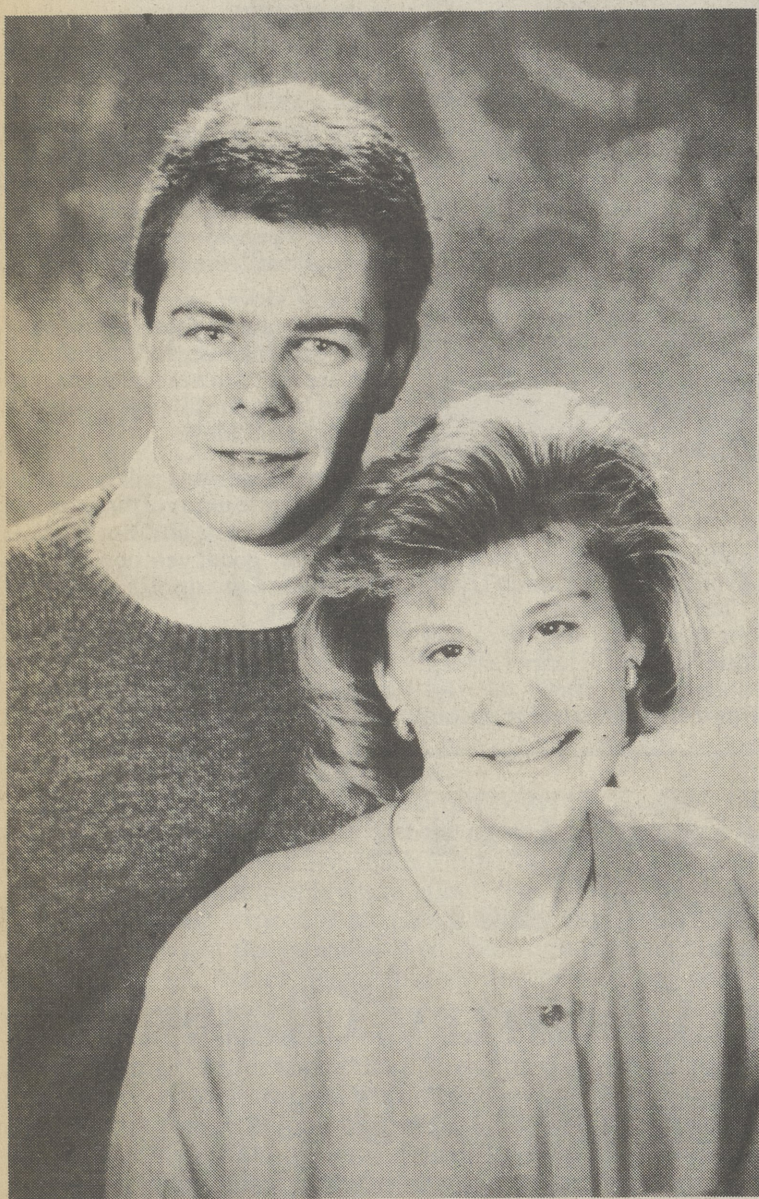
