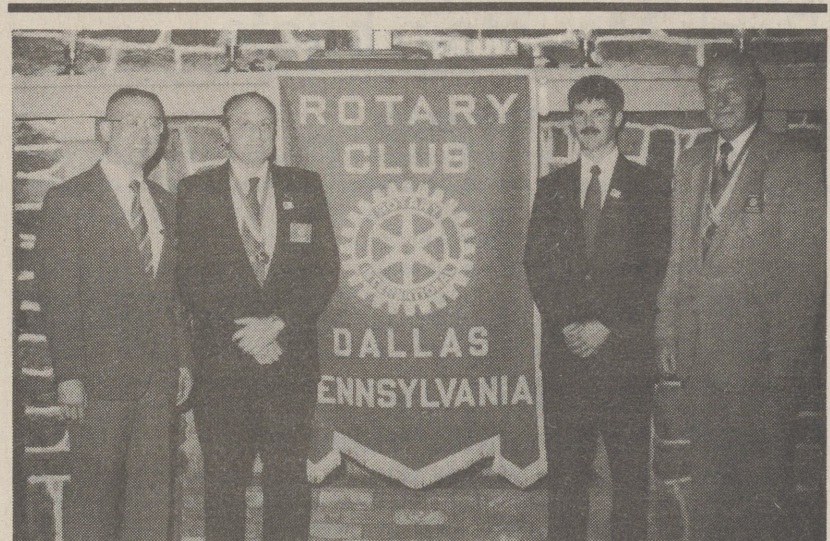
## Troop #241 scouts earn star rank during Court of Honor
