Influenza vaccine free for miners at county locations

Influenza vaccine will be available for miners, former miners, and their spouses at the listed doctors' offices from November 5 to November 30, 1990. Vaccination is available by appointment only. There is no charge for this vaccination. The program is supported by the Coal Workers' Chronic Respiratory Disease Program of the State Health Department and the Luzerne County Medical Society.

Please call the location of your choice if you wish influenza vaccination.

Influenza vaccine is recommended for persons who have had

exposure to coal dust. These persons are especially susceptible to the flu.

Injections for the flu are needed every year for adequate protection. The best time to get the injection is October and November.

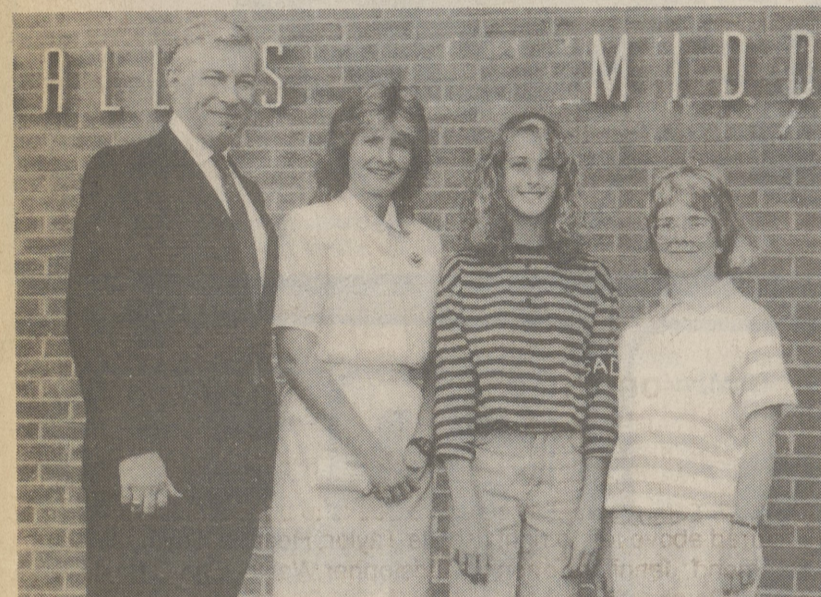
