Lacek received her bachelor of science degree in accounting from Wilkes University, Wilkes-Barre. She resides with her family at Harveys Lake.



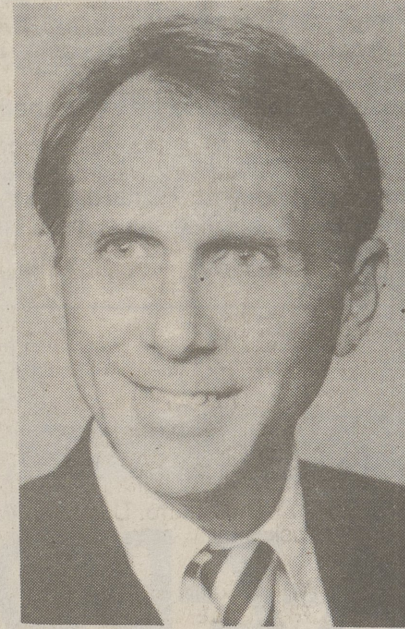
