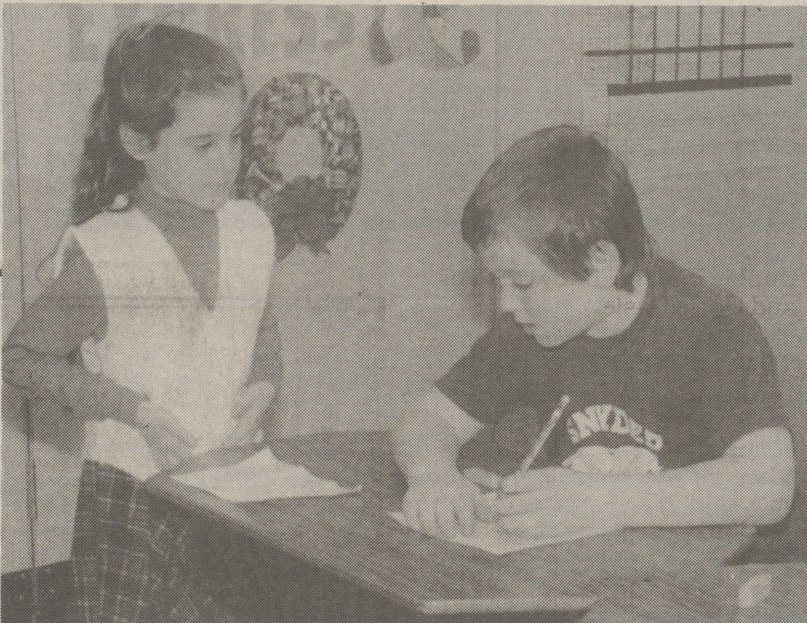
Dear Santa,
