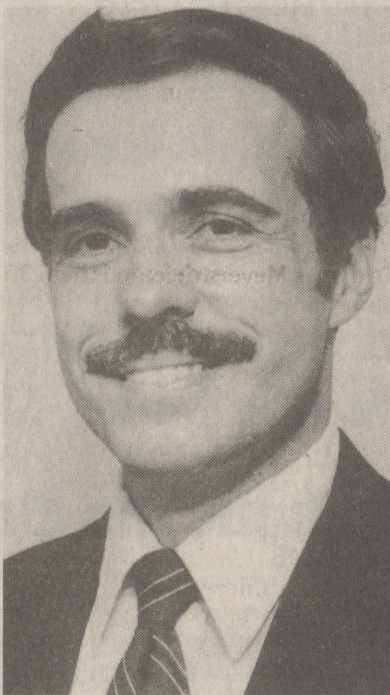
Presper seeks re-election to Lake-Lehman School Board

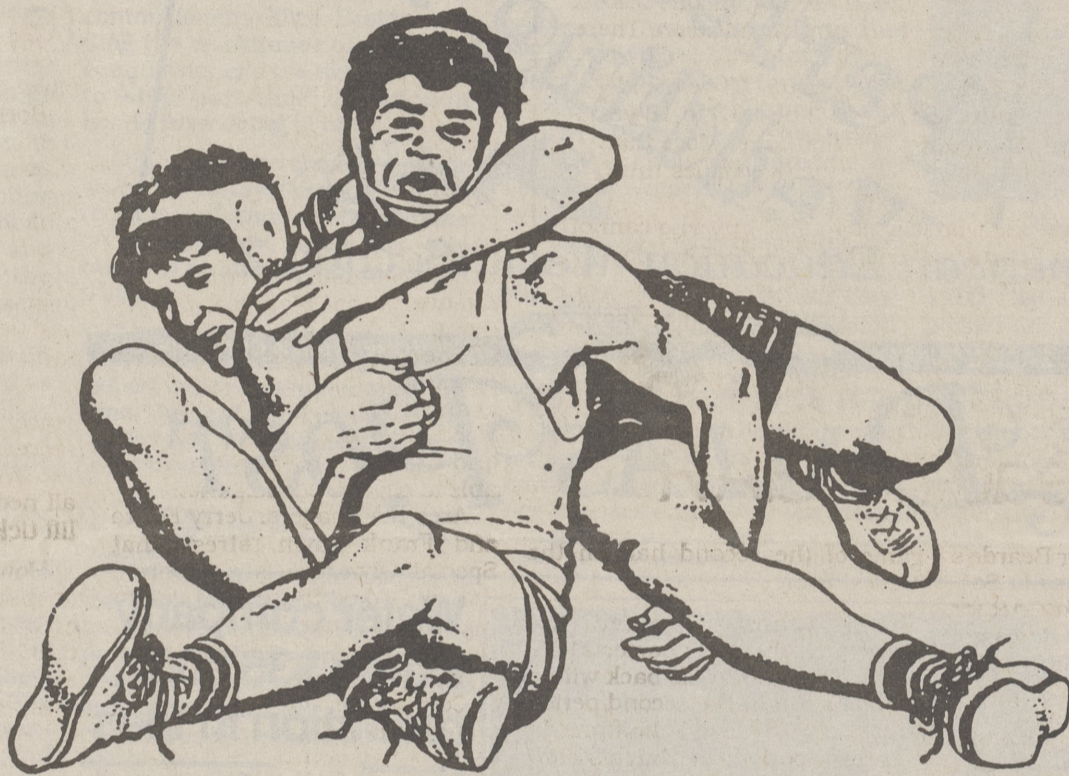
Matthew Shea named semi-finalist for award
