Traditional oils on display at MacDonald Gallery

The MacDonal Art Gallery at College Misericordia opened its spring 1991 season with a one-man exhibition by Hazleton native William Yenkevich. His show, "Traditional Realism in Oil," will be on exhibit in the gallery until February 3.

Yenkevich is a self-taught artist in the traditional academic style of the Old Masters of the 15th to 19th centuries. His goal as an artist, Yenkevich says, "is to record a vision of perfection in a less than perfect age."

The artist attended Columbus College of Art and Design in Columbus, Ohio, has had several solo and juried group exhibitions and has work in many private collections. Yenkevich also teaches the techniques and methods of the old masters in the classical academic way at the Hazleton Art League.

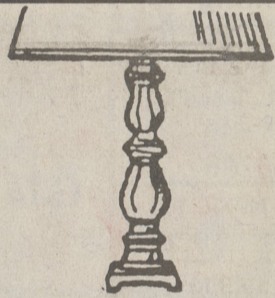
