Dallas Administrative Office Building, Church St., Dallas on March 18, 19, 20 and 21, 1991. Hours Kindergarten program this past will be from 9 a.m. to 12 noon and term, may register on Thursday, l p.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday.

A Birth Certificate or other acceptable evidence of age must accompany each registration. A child must be five (5) years of age on or before September 30, 1991 to make him/her eligible for Kindergarten.

Those with last names beginning with A, B, C, D, E and F will register on Monday,. March 18; those with G, H, I, J, K and L on Tuesday, March 19; those with M, N, O, P, Q and R on Wednesday,

The children who will enter First Grade, but did not attend the Dallas March 21.

In addition to the registration, vision, speech and hearing screenings will be given.

School officials need to review the child's immunizations to be certain the child meets the standards as set by the state regarding immunizations. Parents are to bring all records of their child's immunizations. If the student's records do not meet the standards, he/she will not be able to attend school.
