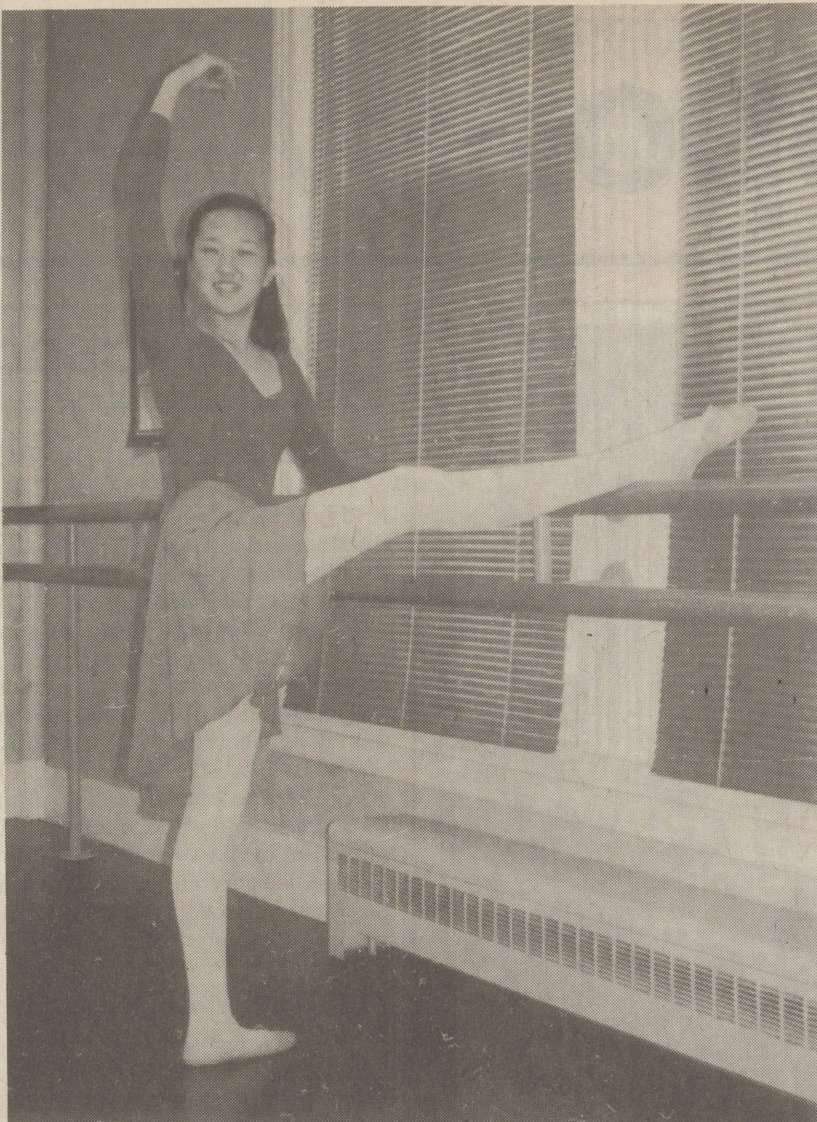
Lady Mounts suffer first loss to Crestwood

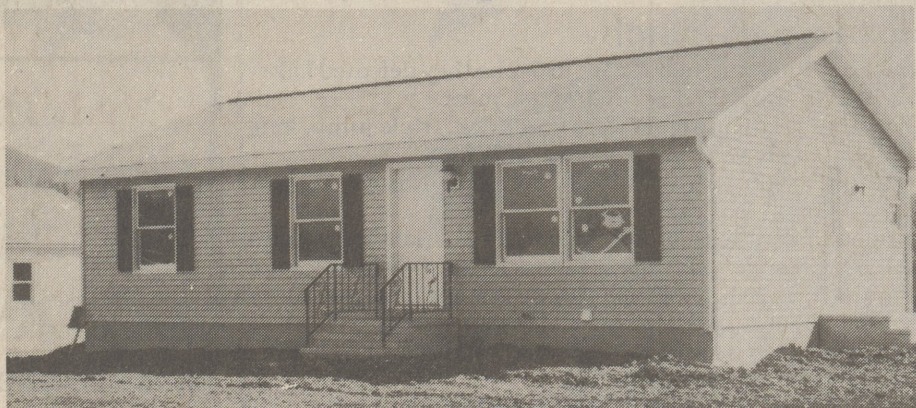
