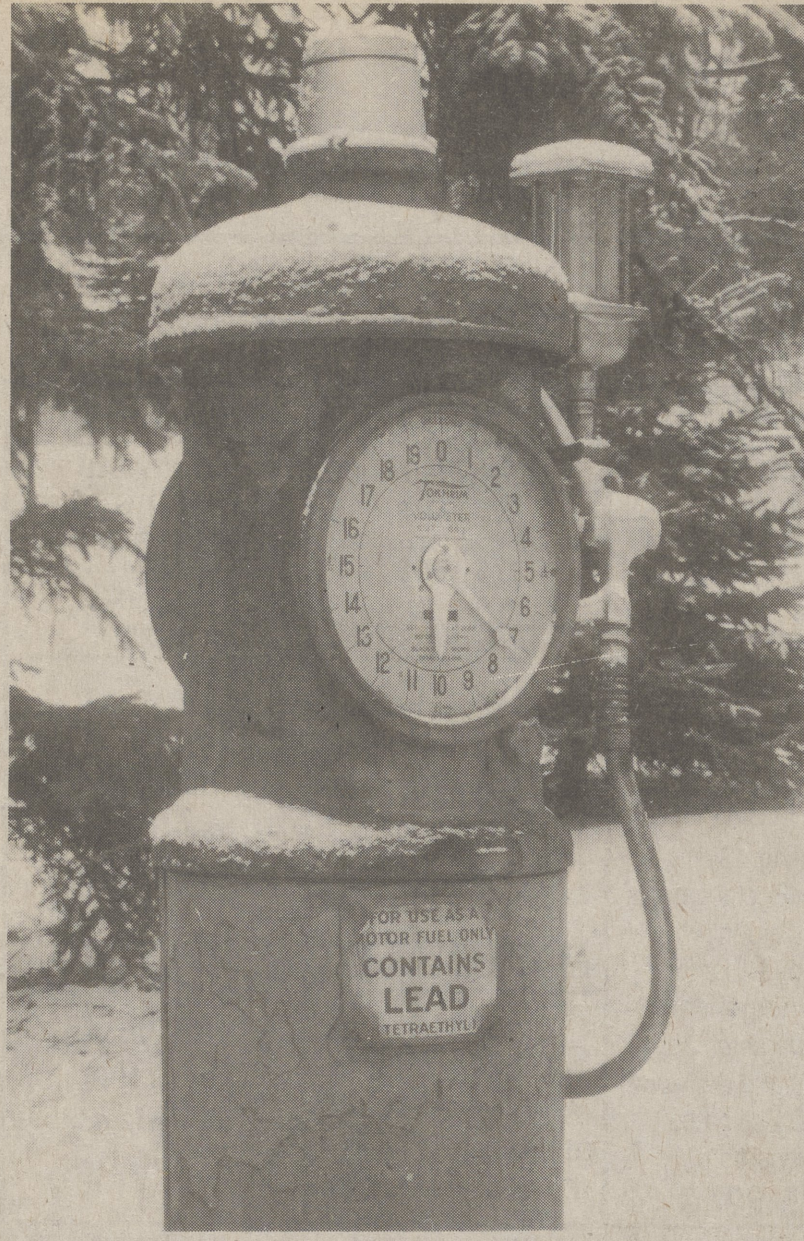
Photographs by Arthur Miller at MacDonald

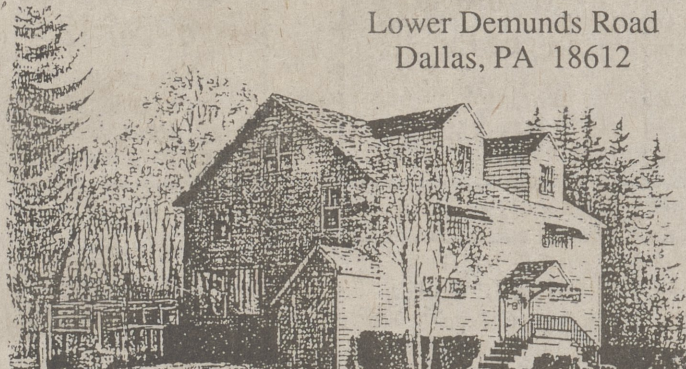

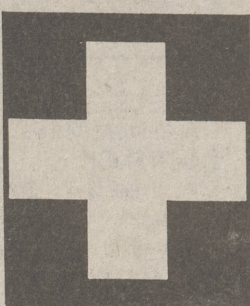
