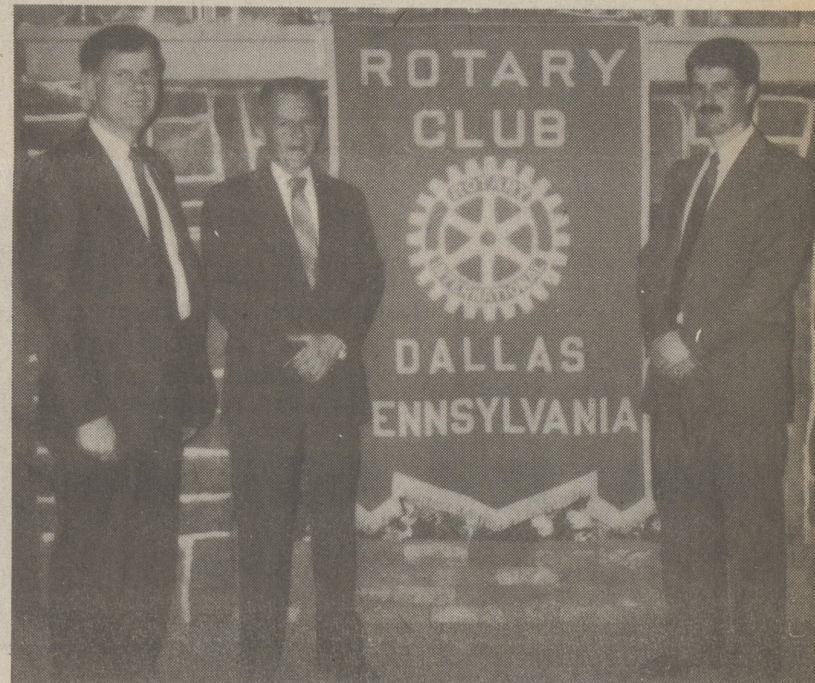
Meadows flea market set for June 15
