

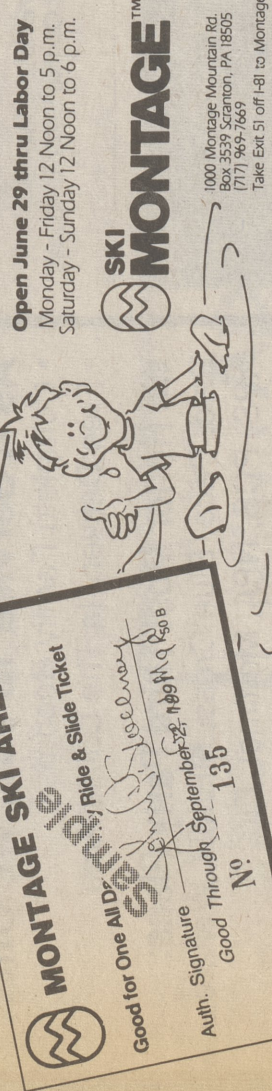

Jaycees come through to take care of the grounds

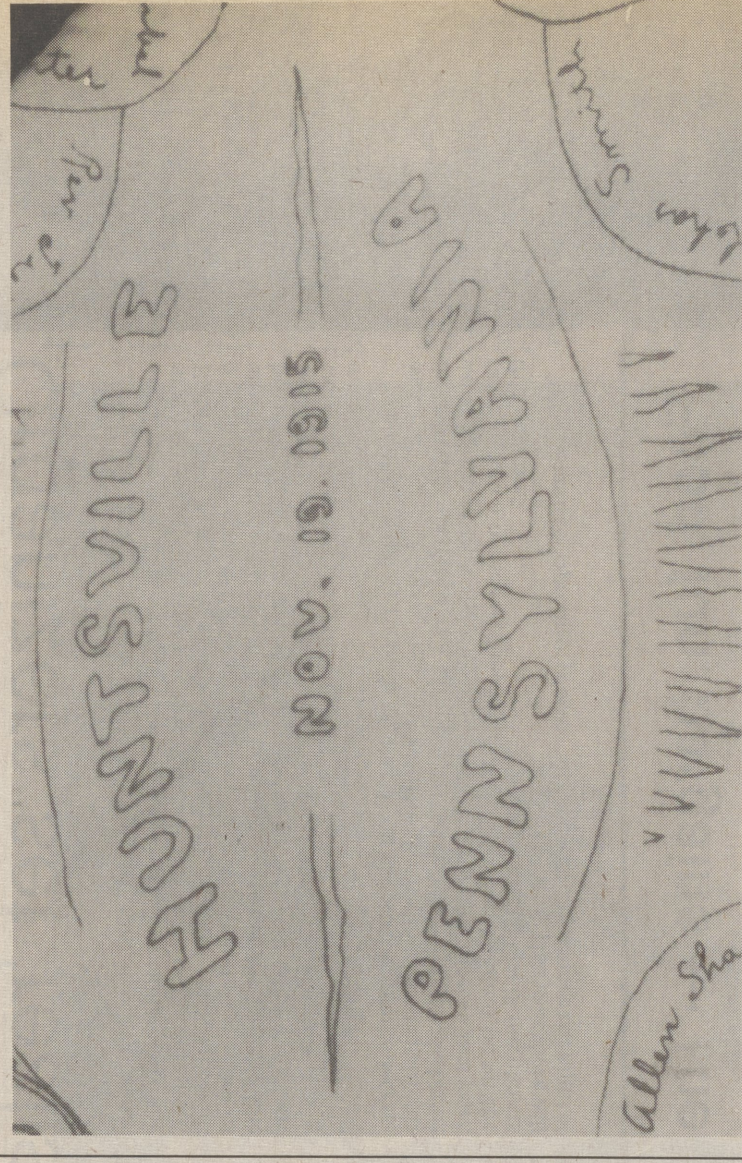

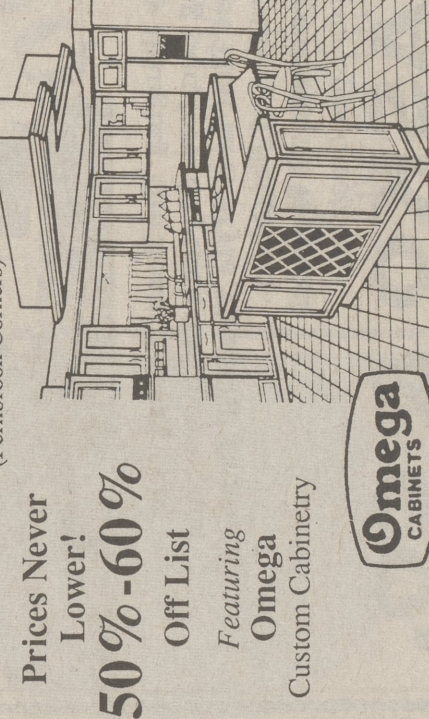

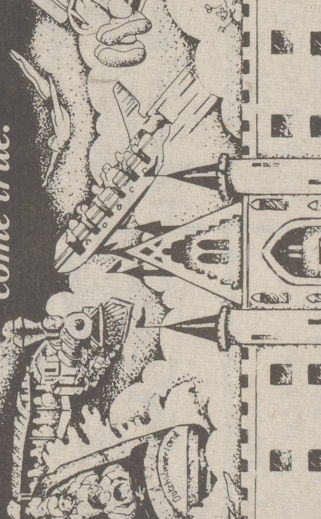
