The program is slated for Wednesday, Aug. 28, at 7 p.m. at the LCCC Educational Conference Center on the main campus in Nanticoke.

General Perugino is assigned to the Headquarters of the Pennsylvania National Guard at Fort Indiare own Gap. General Perugino, when advanced through the enlisted ranks to his present position, is a graduate of the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College and the Army War College. He is a previous commander of the 28th Infantry Division Artillery, Hershey and Battalion Commander of the 1st Battalion 109th Field Artillery, Wilkes-Barre. In addition to his military responsibilities, Perugino is vice president of Administration and Marketing for PG&W. Perug-ino serves on the advisory board of Penn State Wilkes-Barre campus, the board of the Wyoming Commemorative Association and the Crime Clinic of Northeastern Penn-

Perugino was the recipient of the Frank Gibben Memorial Award for outstanding contributions to the improvement of the quality of work life, presented by the American Society of Training Development; and the William Penn Society of Philadelphia chose him as Distinguished Pennsylvanian in


