This is an excellent way to check on what homework was given, and can be used daily to improve homework habits and quality.

Parents may also want to use these numbers in cases of absenteeism. Since the messages are changed by 3:00 p.m. daily, it would be fairly easy to keep up with these class even during absences.

The program will be directed by Mr. Jack Wolensky, Middle School Guidance Counselor with assistance from Mrs. Raelene Olszewski, also a guidance counselor at the middle school. It came about after much research and planning, and should go a long way towards eliminating excuses that are often heard from students regarding homework.
