Culp is one of 128 students in the class of 1995. A 1991 graduate of King's College, Culp received a B.S. degree in Biology, before continuing her education at PCPM.

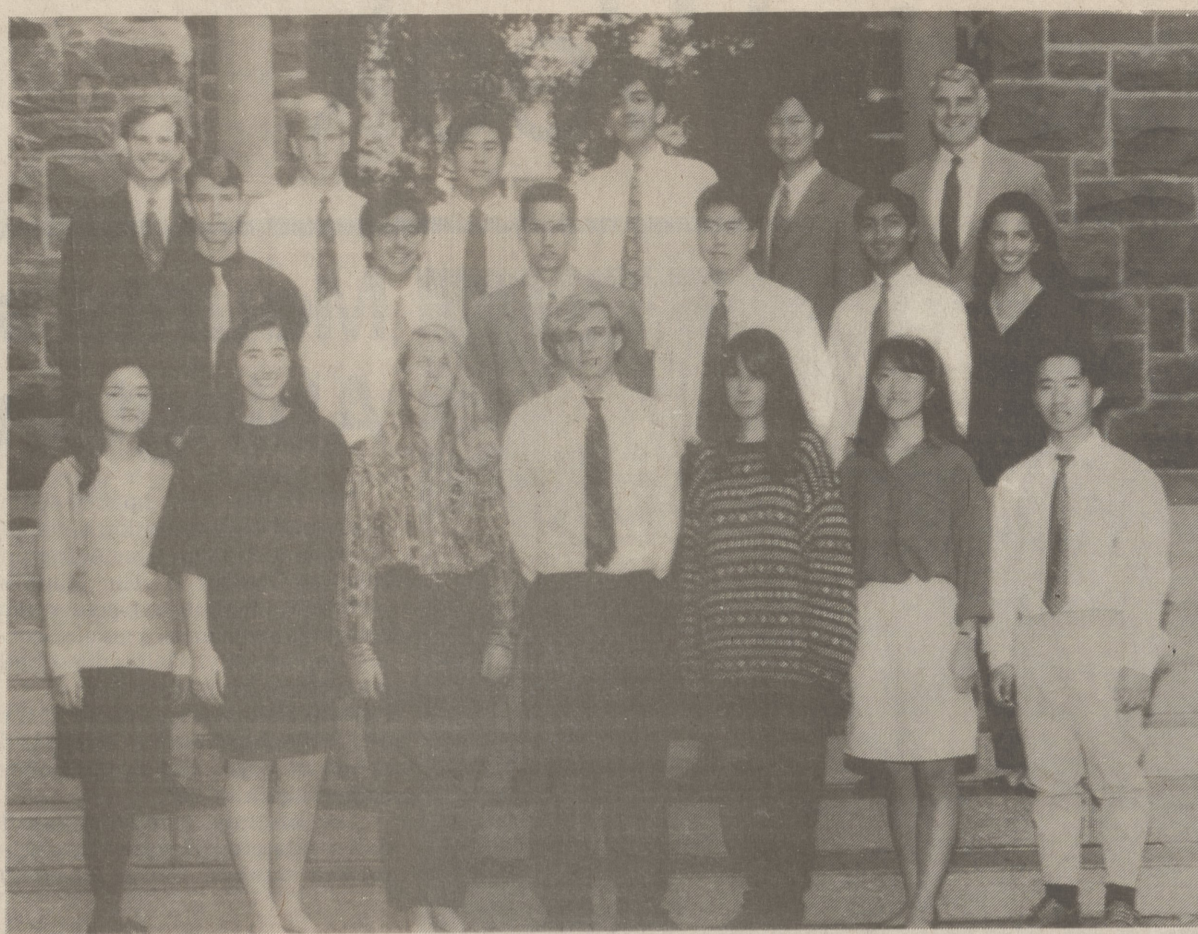
Culp is the daughter of James and Marjorie Culp.
