Historical Society will host steel lecture and exhibit

The Wyoming Historical and Geological Society will open an exhibit on Bethlehem Steel on Thursday evening, February 6 at 7 p.m. with a lecture by Lance Metz, curator/historian of the Hugh Moore Park and Canal Museum. The slide lecture "The History of Bethlehem Steel Corporation and Its Role in America's National Defense" will be followed by a film showing Bethlehem Steel in full operation. Metz will discuss how Bethlehem Steel evolved out of the Lehigh Valley Railroad and the anthracite/iron industry to become the largest military production plant in the world.

The Bethlehem Steel Exhibit, which will be on display in the Museum's main gallery through

February 29, was developed by the Hugh Moore Park and Canal Museum in Easton, PA in conjunction with a Historic American Engineering Record (HAER) project to document Bethlehem Steel. AHAER study of the Huber Breaker in Ashley, conducted in the summer of 1991, will form the basis for an exhibit scheduled to open at the Wyoming Historical and Geological Society Museum in October, 1992.

The lecture, open to the public free of charge, will be held in the main gallery of the Society's Museum at 69 South Franklin St., behind the Osterhout Library. There will be a reception following the lecture, and an opportunity to view the exhibit.

Rep. Mundy offers advice on tax forgiveness procedure

Rep. Phyllis Mundy, Kingston, wants to remind residents, especially senior citizens and those on a fixed income, filing for the special income tax forgiveness to closely follow the instructions on pages 27 through 29 of PA 40 tax form.

"In order to claim the tax forgiveness on line 14a, you must first read instructions on page 27 to determine if you're eligible for this tax forgiveness using the Eligibility Income Table on page 29 and then record the amount on your tax form," Mundy explained.

The Department of Revenue provides a free income tax preparation service for individuals who are elderly, on a fixed or limited

income, handicapped or housebound. Uncomplicated federal, state and local income tax returns are prepared by the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance and Tax Counseling for the Elderly programs.

Mundy encourages residents who think they may qualify to contact the Pennsylvania Revenue Department district offices for information or call the Internal Revenue Service's toll free number at 1-800-829-1040.

"Many people who qualify for this special tax forgiveness, commonly referred to as poverty exemption, are unaware of how to properly file for this exemption on their tax form," Mundy said.

Misericordia accounting students offer help preparing tax returns

Nearly 25 junior and senior accounting majors at College Misericordia will provide a valuable service to the community this tax season when they participate in the IRS-sponsored VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) Program, according to Fred J. Croop, chair of Misericordia's business department and coordinator of this year's VITA Program at Misericordia.

The VITA Program, now in its 22nd year of service nationwide, is designed to provide free assistance to those persons with special needs, including people with disabilities, low-income families and senior citizens. This program, according to Croop, fits in well with the goals of the accounting program and Misericordia's mission.

Croop says Misericordia students have been trained to handle simple state and federal tax re-

turns for persons filing Form 1040EZ, Form 1040A, or a basic 1040 Federal Tax Return.

The IRS has provided Misericordia with the necessary materials for the VITA Program which begins at the College, Monday, Feb. 3, and continues through Monday, April 13. Walk-in hours are provided on the fourth floor of the Administration Building on Mondays from 5 to 7:30 p.m., and on Saturdays from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. (No hours available on Saturday, Feb. 29.) Appointments may be made for other hours by calling 674-6327.

Taxpayers who visit the VITA site at Misericordia should bring with them 1991's tax package, wage and earning statements (W-2's for the year) from all employers, interest and dividend statements (1099's), a copy of 1990 tax return, and other relevant information.
