The Department of Revenue provides a free income tax preparation service for individuals who are elderly, on a fixed or limited income, handicapped or house-bound. Uncomplicated federal, state and local income tax returns are prepared by the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance and Tax Counseling for the Elderly pro-

Mundy encourages residents who think they may qualify to contact the Pennsylvania Revenue Department district offices for information or call the Internal Revenue Service's toll free number at 1-

"Many people who qualify for this special tax forgiveness, commonly referred to as poverty exemption, are unaware of how to properly file for this exemption on their tax form," Mundy said.
