## Bible School workshop Mar. 7

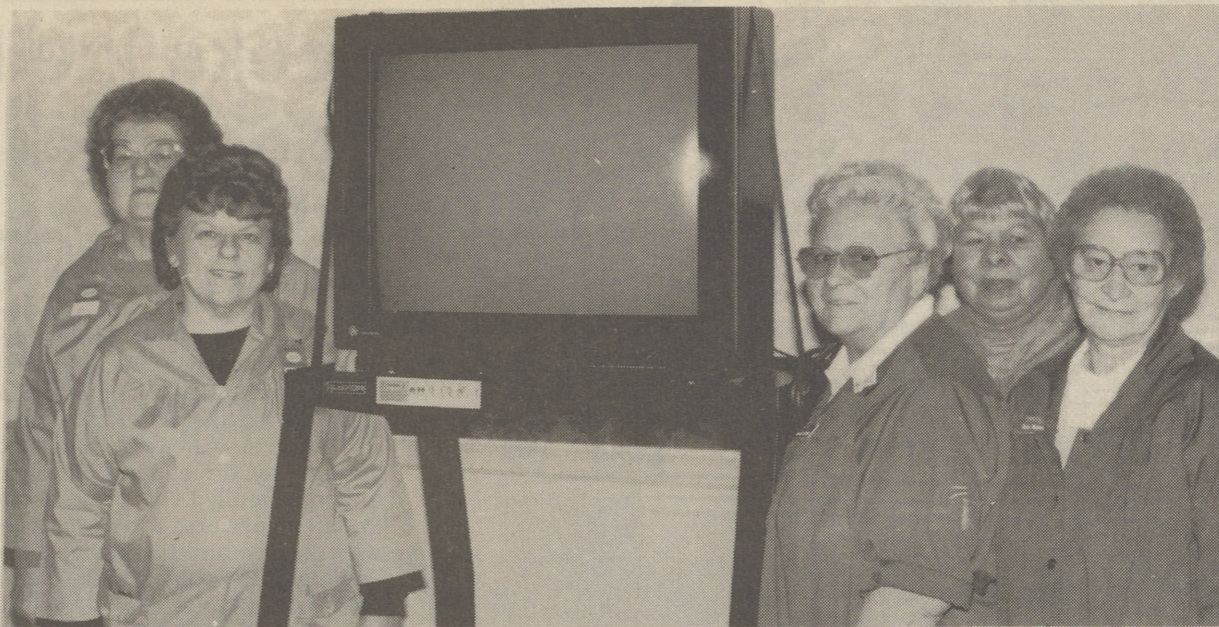
