

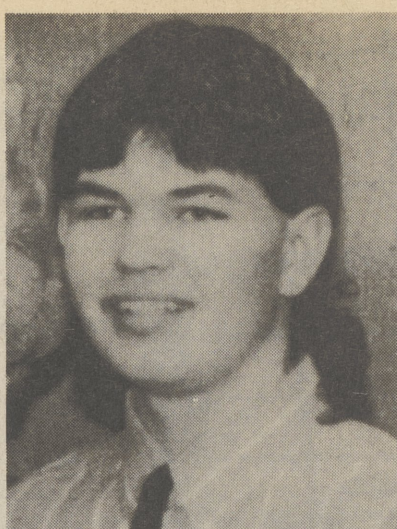
Keith Rinehimer honored by national company for heroism

Keith Rinehimer has been honored as one of 25 Americans chosen to receive the Kleenex Says Bless You Honorable Mention Award for extraordinary heroic efforts in 1991.

Rinehimer, a student at Dallas High School, was nominated for the award by Congressman Paul Kanjorski and received an acrylic plaque along with a congratulatory letter from the Kimberly-Clark Corporation.

Rinehimer is credited with possibly preventing Dr. Wallace Stettler from being paralyzed after an auto accident last fall. He was chosen for the award for running in front of Stettler's aimlessly rolling car and frantically waving at other drivers in order to stop oncoming traffic.

Ten winners and twenty-five honorable mentions for the award were selected through a poll of newspaper editors, television news directors and U.S. Congressmen and women.

In addition, Eric Lee has created an outstanding new Chinese Restaurant, doubling the size of his former facility. After only several months, Eric has immediate expansion

plans. Humford Equities, shopping center manager, reports that only two stores are presently available, one of 1,050 square feet and one of 5,460 square feet, adjacent B. Levy.

A Humford Equities spokesman stated, "The Dallas Shopping Center has maintained a very strong performance record, even during recessionary times, and we expect that the renovation project, completed at the same time as the completion of the new Cross Valley Expressway, will have a very positive impact on customer counts and resulting sales for all tenants."
