## Area dancers take top honors

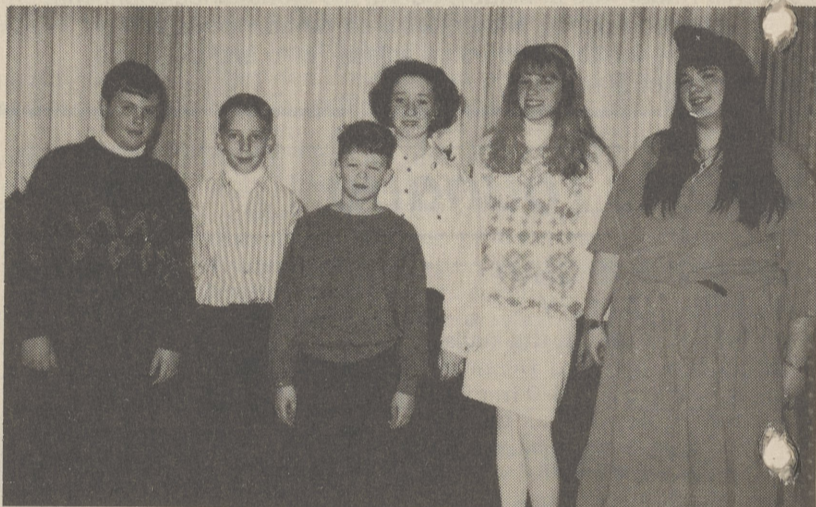
