Airshow will feature famous wingwalker team

Veteran airshow performers Dave Dacy and Johnny Kazian have joined forces to present one of the greatest Wing-Walking acts of all time. They will be among the featured attractions as the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton International Airport presents Airshow '92 on Friday and Saturday, July 11 and 12.

Dave Dacy will be at the controls of the big, blue Super Stearman bi-wing aerobatic aircraft while Johnny Kazian is anywhere but in the passenger seat. Dacy puts the aircraft through a complete low level aerobatic performance including loops, rolls, hammerhead turns, and high speed dives while Kazian is out on, between, or under the wings of the aircraft. While on top of the Super Stearman Kazian performs his own routine that includes his trademark, a headstand.

Airshow '92 gates will open each day at 9 a.m. and close at 6 p.m. with parking being provided at the enlarged lots on the airport grounds and at Rocky Glen Park at Exit 50 of Interstate 81 and also at the Lackawanna County Multi-Purpose Stadium at Exit 51. Free shuttle buses will provide transportation from these lots to and from the Airshow gates. Tickets will be sold only at the airport gates and cost \$8 for adults, \$3 for children ages 6 through 12 and children under 6 are admitted free when accompanied by an adult.

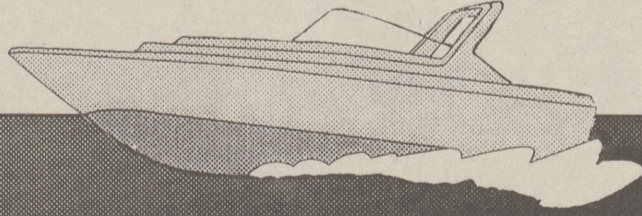

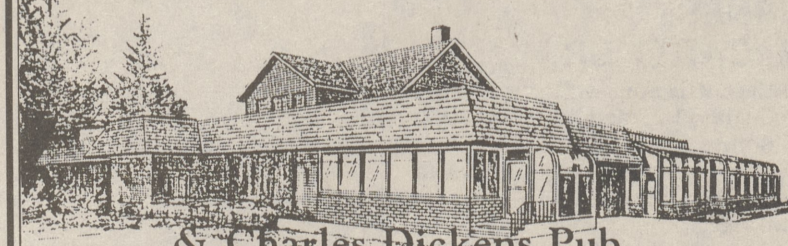
