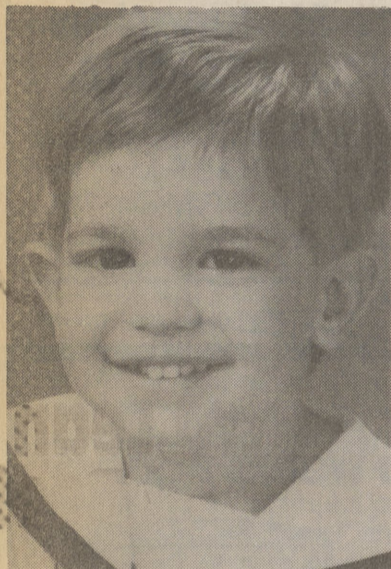
Sharon Vogt will marry Erik Santos

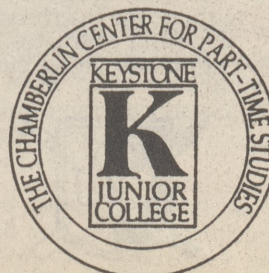
