profit organization, Leadership Wilkes-Barre brings together new

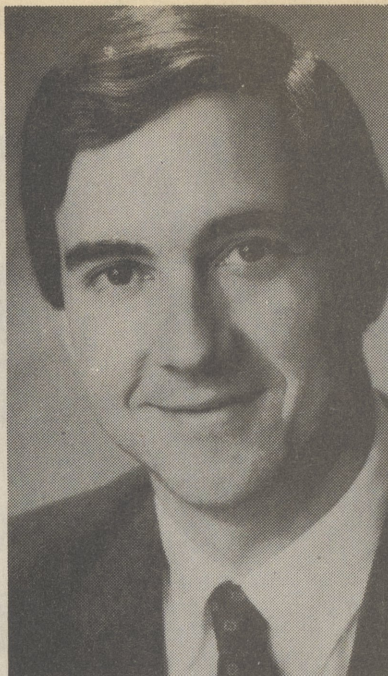
and emerging leaders from throughout the Wyoming Valley to inform and expose participants to concerns of the community. It

of their professionalism and consistent high production.

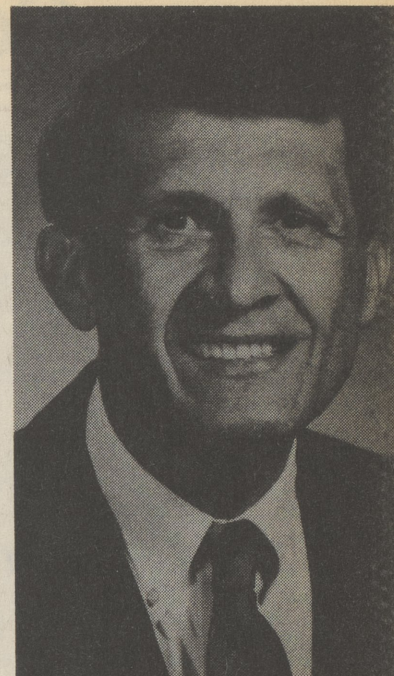
As recognition of this prestigious acknowledgement, Ostrowski has been awarded permanent membership into the Chairman's Council during his tenure with Prudential Securities.

P.O. BRIAN BAKER RETURNS FROM SEA WITH CARRIER EARLY WARNING SQUADRON

Navy Petty Officer 3rd Class Brian L. Baker, son of Lee A. and Evelyn G. Baker of 37 Stafford Street, Trucksville recently returned with Carrier Airborne Early Warning Squadron-121 based at Norfolk, VA from a six-month deployment.

While embarked aboard the aircraft carrier USS Dwight D. Eisenhower, Baker participated in exercises in the Atlantic Ocean, Mediterranean Sea, Red Sea and Persian Gulf, as well as in the NATO multinational exercise "Teamwork 92" in the Norwegian Sea.

Teamwork 92 is designed to improve the professionalism and effectiveness of the NATO forces. Operations are conducted in the realistic environment of the North Atlantic and coastal waters of Norway, included maritime, air, amphibious and field training exercises.

The squadron flies the EA-6B "Prowler" aircraft, used in airborne electronic countermeasures.

Baker visited Dubai, United Arab Emirates and Palma, Spain. He joined the Navy in June 1988.
