

Free or reduced price lunches, milk are available

Free and Reduced Price Meal Program - Special Milk Program for those children unable to pay the full price of meals or milk. The sponsor has adopted the following family size and income criteria as established by the Secretary of the United States Department of Agriculture for determining eligibility. Children from families whose income is at or below the levels shown below are eligible for free meals or milk or reduced-price meals.

To apply for free or reduced-price meals or free milk, complete the application sent home by your school with a letter to parents, sign it and return it to the school. Additional copies are available from the school.

FOOD STAMP/AFDC HOUSEHOLDS: If you currently receive Food Stamps or "Aid to Families with Dependent Children" (AFDC) for your child, you only have to list your child's name and food stamp or AFDC case number, print your

name, and sign the application. Since you have already given income information to the welfare office, the school can confirm your eligibility.

ALL OTHER HOUSEHOLDS: If your household income is at or below the level shown above, your child is eligible for free or reduced-price meals or free milk.

You may apply for benefits any time during the school year. If you are not eligible now but have a decrease in household income, an increase in household size, or become unemployed, fill out an application at that time.

Children who receive free or reduced-price meal or free milk benefits are treated the same as children who pay for their meals or milk. In the operation of child nutrition programs, no child will be discriminated against because of race, sex, color, national origin, age or handicap. If you believe you

It is essential that the district be informed, as soon as possible, of all new students planning to register, especially the Kindergarten and first grade students.

Problems occur with class and school building assignments as well as transportation arrange-

ments when students are registered late.

Parents of new students or those transferring from other schools are strongly encouraged to register their children immediately. Late elementary registrants may not be assigned to the most convenient school building.

All Kindergarten through fifth grade students are to register at the Administration Building, Church St., Dallas. Middle and

Senior High students will register at their respective school offices located on Conyngham Ave., Dallas.

Parents must bring birth certificates, report cards from the previous school and immunization records. No student will be allowed to enter school without proof of the required immunizations.

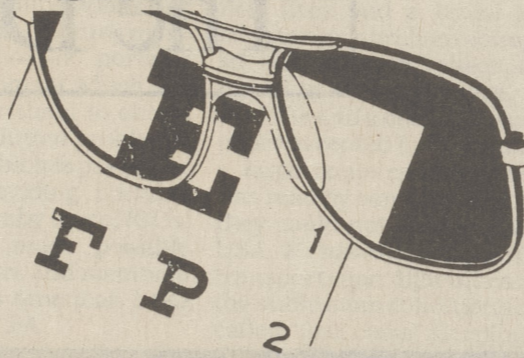

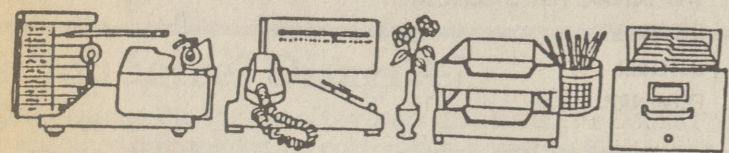

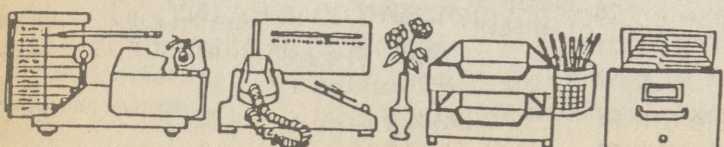
