academy's Bobette Dance team and will be performing as a Cygnette in the production. Four other members of the team were chosen as Cygnettes.

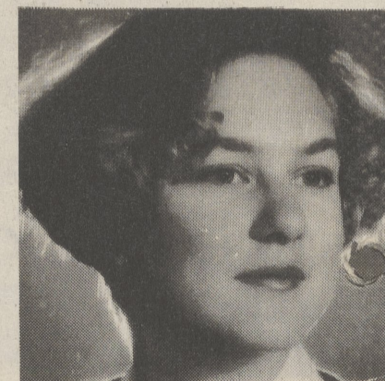
