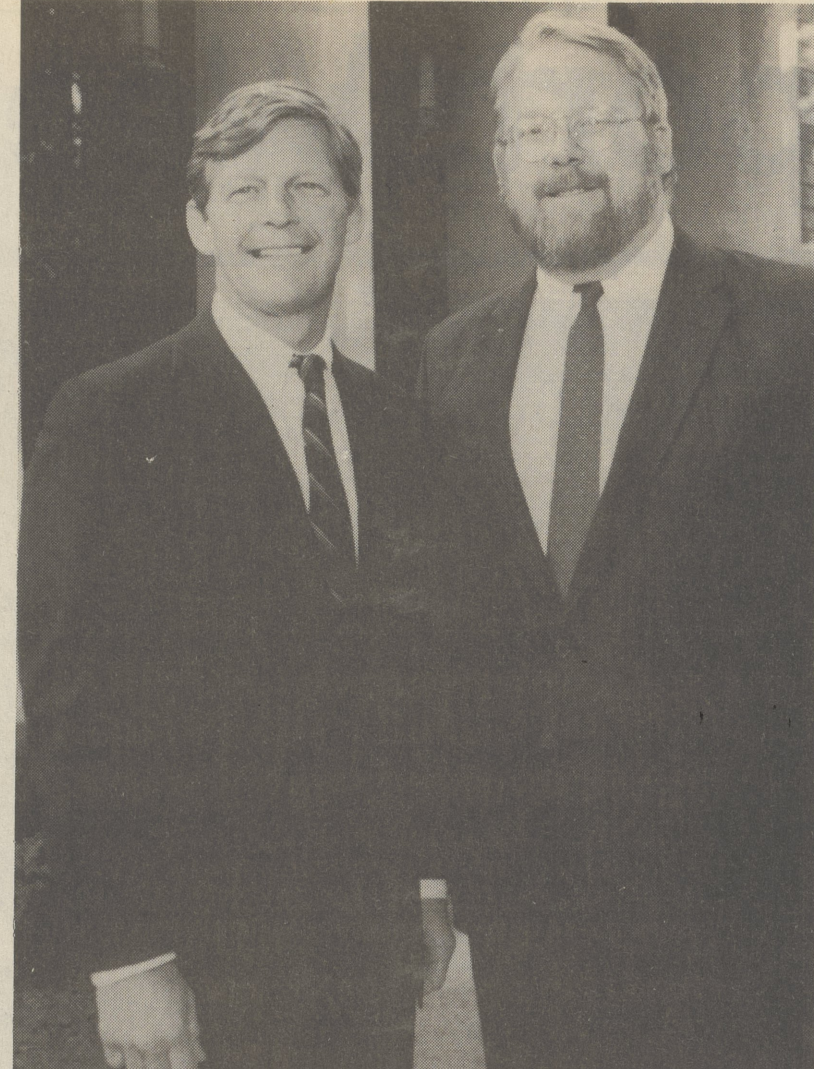
Baluh is Foundation Honors Scholar at Clarion University

Charles D. Flack, Jr. of Dallas, has been named national chairman of the 1992-1993 Annual Fund campaign for Wyoming Seminary College Preparatory School, Kingston, according to H. Jeremy Packard, president. The campaign goal set by the Annual Fund Committee is \$450,000. A special highlight of this year's campaign is "The Drive for 45," a challenge instituted by the class of 1972 to increase alumni participation rate to 45 percent.


