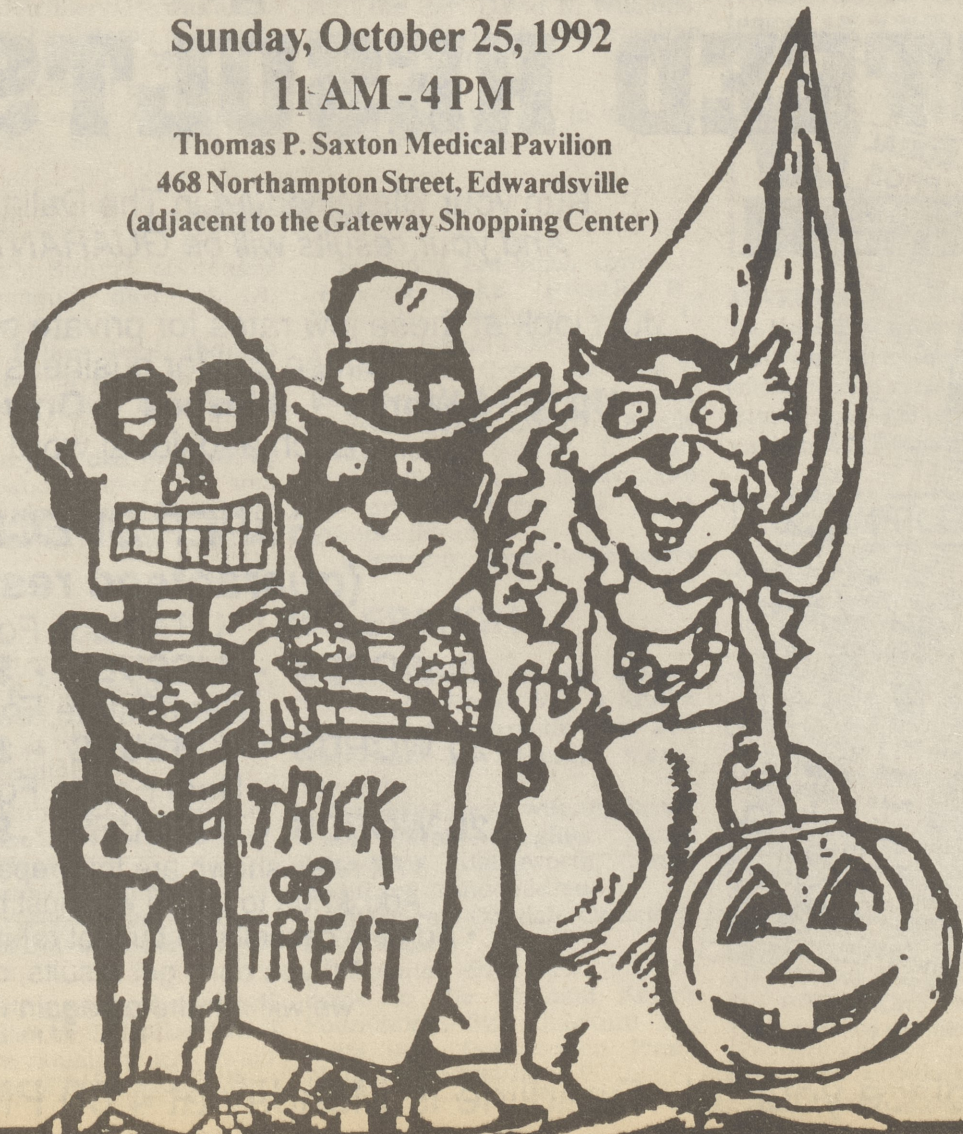
The portable high-intensity lights rented by the Booster Club lit the field nearly as well as the lights in any of the valley high school stadiums.
