State Representatives get full salary/benefit package

According to material furnished by the Bipartisan Management Committee, Pennsylvania law allows a state representative these expenses benefits, reimbursements:

Benefits:

session year runs from December 1 through November 30.

• Health insurance: Blue Cross/ Blue Shield/Major Medical with dental and vision care, prescription drug reimbursement.

Retirement: percent of his or her yearly salary.

• Life insurance: \$40,000 group term policy, disability and accidental death insurance.

Expenses: month to lease an Americanmanufactured car.

• Mileage: reimbursed only for trips to and from Harrisburg. Each representative works out the formula individually because some would rather deduct the total amount from their income taxes; the average figure is 22.5¢ per

• Housing allowance: \$88 per day while in Harrisburg for meals and lodging.

• District office expenses: up to \$800 per month to rent a district office and its furniture, pay for utilities and purchase supplies. (The state provides representatives' offices in Harrisburg.)

Representatives' staff members • Yearly salary: \$47,000 (A are on the House of Representatives

Reimbursements made annually by the House Chief Clerk, after the representative provides sufficient documentation.

• Home office expenses: the each representative will be reimbursed representative contributes 6.25 up to \$10,000 per year for expenses associated with operating a district office and not covered by district offfice expenses.

• Postage: \$2,000 per year.

Accountable expenses: • Car allowance: up to \$650 per \$10,000 per year for other onth to lease an American-expenses, including travel expenses not associated with House sessions, insurance for leased vehicle and additional postage. If a representative does not lease a car, he or she may be reimbursed for mileage on their personal vehicles at 22.5¢ per mile.

The number of days that representatives spend in session varies from year to year.






