## Testing for Wyoming Sem scholarship set for Feb. 13

Wyoming Seminary College Preparatory School, Kingston, will sponsor its 12th Trustee Achievement Scholarship competition on Saturday, Feb. 13. Merit scholarships of varying amounts will be awarded to five students who excel in academics, according to John R. Eidam, dean of admission.

Five scholarships will be awarded regardless of economic need. Recipients may also apply for financial aid if additional assistance is needed.

The awards will be granted to the students who, in the judgment of the Trustee Achievement Scholarship committee, combine outstanding performance on a

competitive examination, with high qualities of citizenship, and a strong record of academic achievement.

Any student entering the ninth or 10th grade and not now enrolled at Wyoming Seminary College Preparatory School may compete for the scholarships. Candidates interested in applying should contact the Admission Office, Wyoming Seminary, Kingston 18704-3593.

Candidates will then be asked to submit a scholarship application, participate in an interview before members of the scholarship committee and complete the February 13 examination.

## Registration next week for Gate of Heaven kindergarten

Mrs. Mary C. Tighe, Principal, announces that registration for the 1993-94 Kindergarten classes will be held on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, Jan. 19, 20 and 21 from 9:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. in the school lobby on the first floor.

Children entering Kindergarten in September, 1993, must be five years of age before September 30, 1993.

Information needed at this time includes proof of immunization. Eligibility immunizations are 3 DPT, 3 oral polio, and the following vaccines administered at 12 months or older: measles, mumps and rubella. Parents must present all records of the child's immunization in compliance with state standards for immunization.

Birth certificate, social security and Baptismal records are also required; non-Catholic students need only present birth certificate, social security number and immunization records. All parents must complete the financial responsibility form and have their pastor sign the parish affiliation form.
