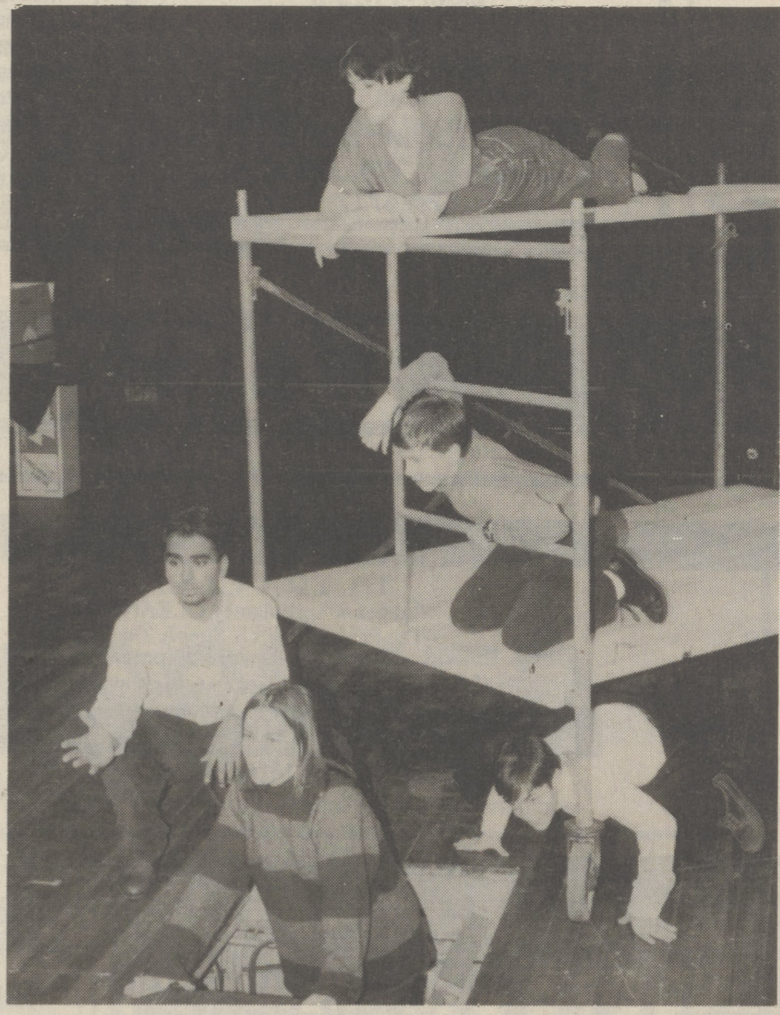
Seminary Players present Shakespeare
