# Pinocchio will open at Music Box March 5

Pinocchio, the tale of the little wooden boy whose nose grows bigger each time he tells a lie, will open this season's Music Box schedule of children's theatre. This original musical adaptation of the classic Italian story was first presented in 1990 and is being restaged by popular demand.
