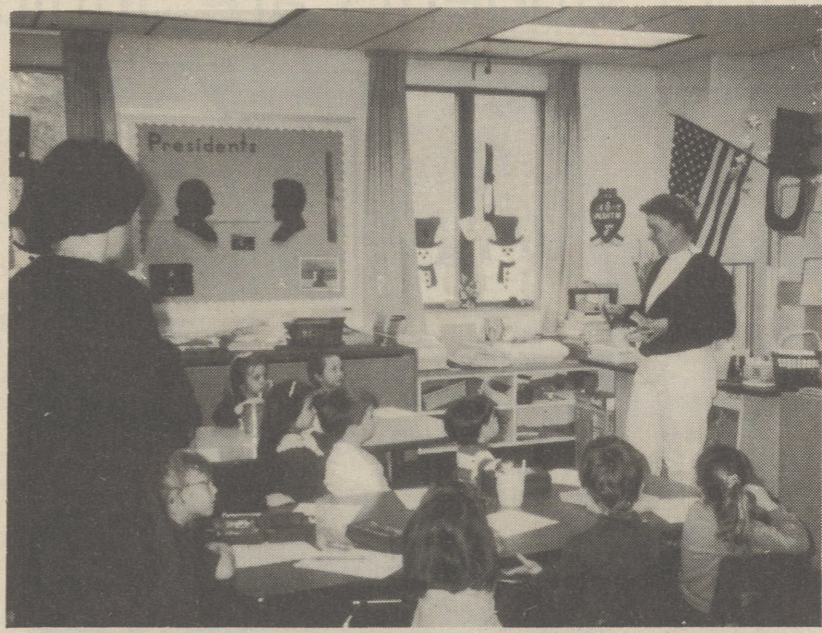
This production will incorporate colorful period costuming created by Ms. Aubrey Ide and her
