Zone variance requested for 4-family home

The Dallas Borough Zoning Hearing Board will consider a request April 22 for a variance to build a four-family home in an area zoned for one and two-family

William Cave of West Center Hill Road, wants to build a 3,328 square foot two-story structure at 51 Lehman Avenue. The building would contain four apartments, with parking for eight cars in the rear on the 75 by 150 foot lot. The neighborhood was rezoned to R-2 last year when Dallas Borough adopted new zoning codes.

Mrs. Cave said the apartments would all be rented and that she and her husband would not live in the building.

An R-2 zone allows single or two-family homes on minimum 7,000 square foot lots. Until last year, the neighborhood had been zoned R-1, which allowed single and two-family homes on lots of at least 10,000 square feet. An R-3 zone, which allows multi-family dwellings, was added last year in the area of Franklin, Ridge and Main streets.

The hearing is scheduled to begin at 7 p.m., Thursday, April 22 in the Dallas Borough Building on Main Street.




