## Last call for Sweet Valley ambulance ass'n membership

Over six weeks ago, Sweet Valley Ambulance Association, Inc., launched its 1993 Subscription Campaign. As of April 30, the Subscription Plan will come to an end. We have received some subscriptions to date but have mailed a second appeal to all residents who have not joined our membership plan to date. If you haven't joined, please take this opportunity to lend us your financial support. If you have already contributed, we thank you.

Alice Walsh, Treasurer, explained how the membership drive impacts on the organization's other income generator known as third party billing. Since not all services are reimbursable, without your participation in our membership drive, very soon there would be a shortage of funding to

cover operating expenses and update equipment.

Your health insurance company may not reimburse us for certain services we provide on an ambulance call. As a subscriber you will not be billed any additional charges. But, if you choose not to subscribe, you will be billed directly.

In summary, whenever a subscriber uses our ambulance, a bill is submitted to their insurance company. If the insurance company reimburses any portion of the bill, it is accepted as payment in full by our ambulance service. However, if the insurance company denies a claim for any reason, the subscriber is not charged

anything further.

On the other hand, if a non-subscriber uses the ambulance, he is billed directly for services (except Medicare and Medical Assistance) and is responsible for the total invoiced amount.

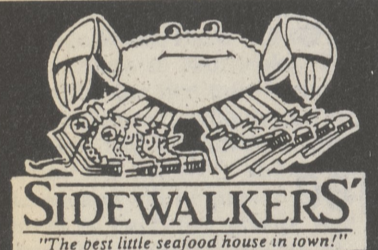
