



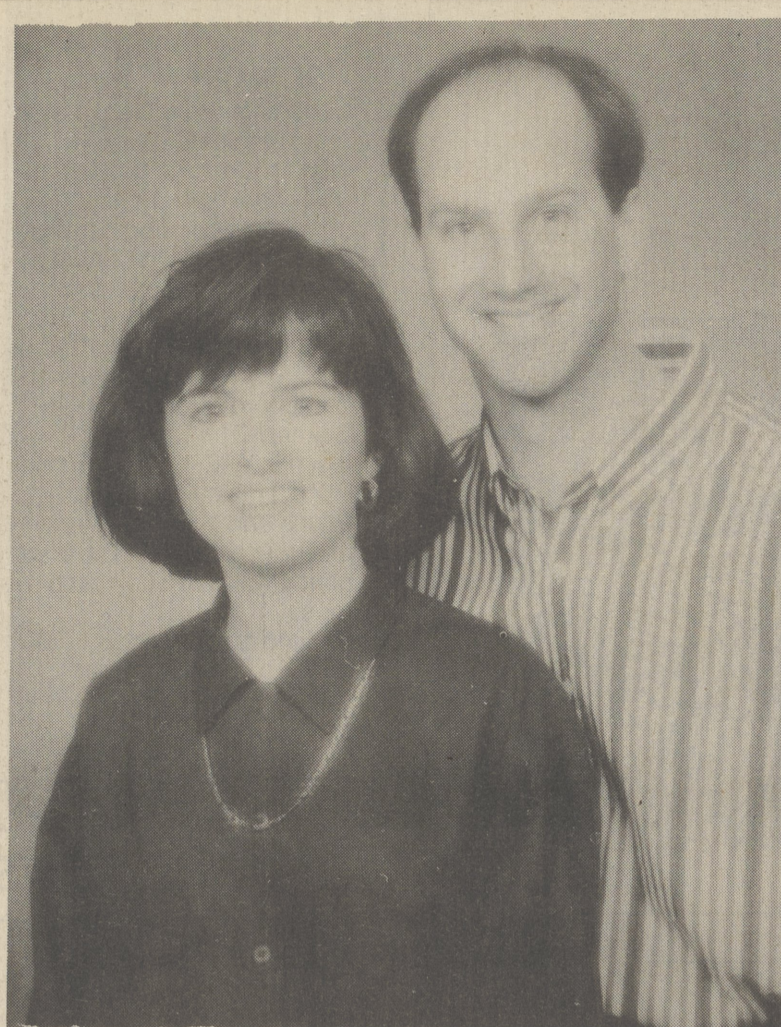
CHRISTINA WHISPELL AND RUSSELL E. RACE IV
