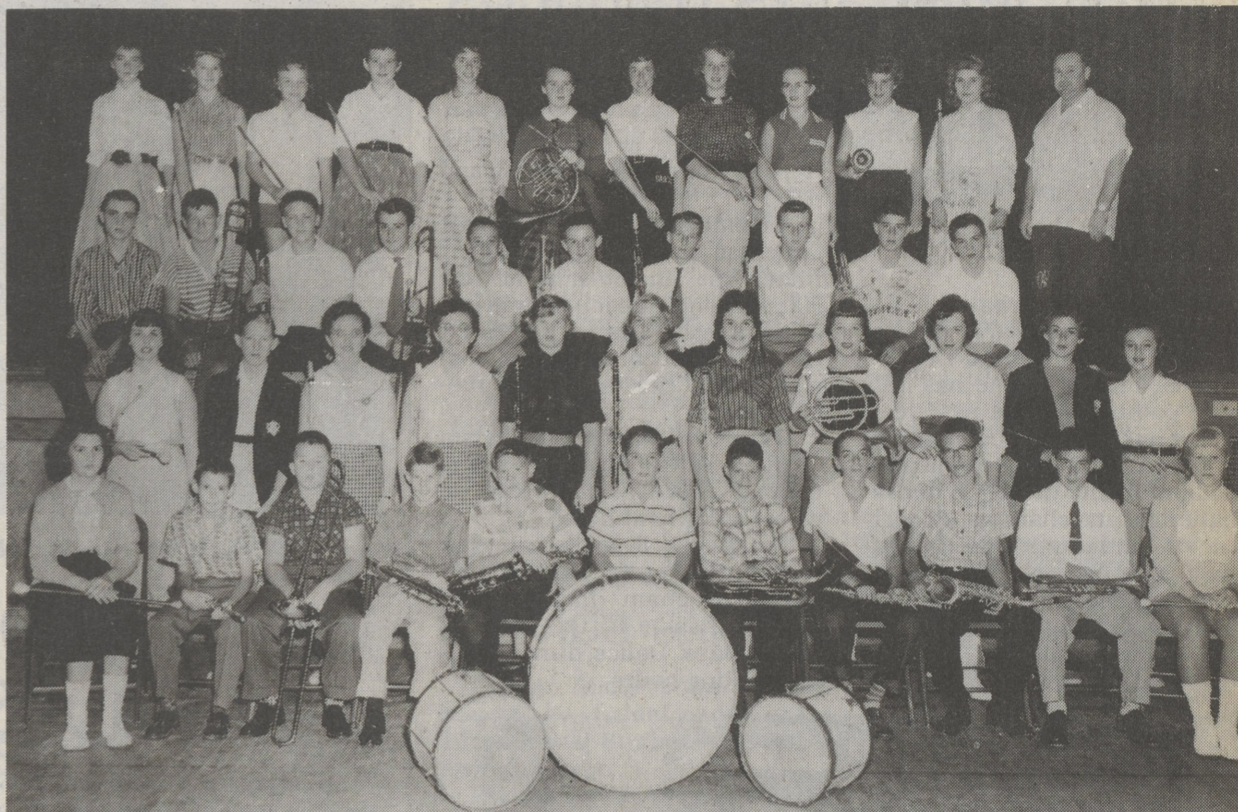
the model builder. The display will be at the library until July 7.

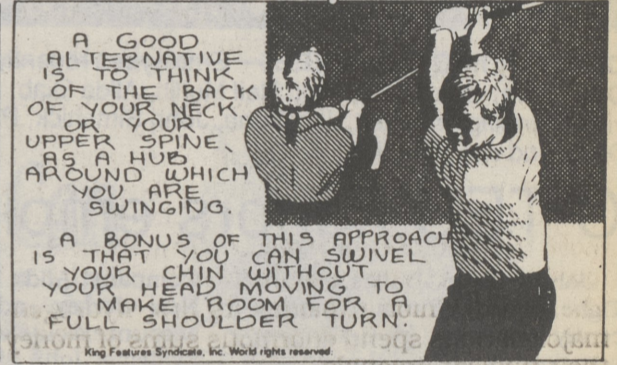
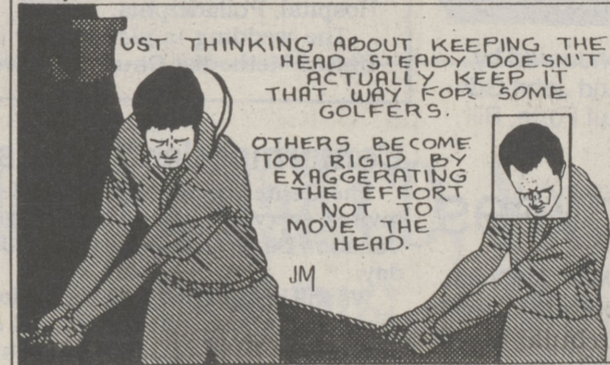
