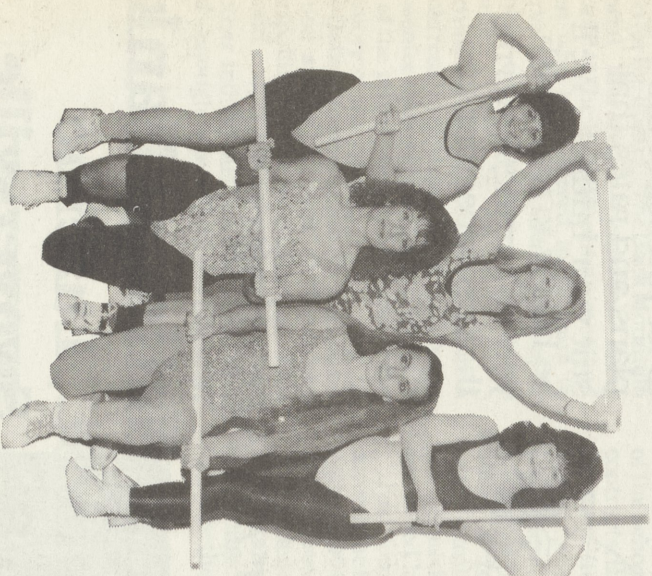

## Facts and figures about the Back Mountain Memorial Library

- Did you know that the Back Mountain Memorial Library -
- Carries a total inventory of 57,775 items, including books, records and tapes.
- Circulates nearly 94,000 items every year.
- Has nearly 12,000 active borrowers.
- Welcomed 1,684 new borrowers in 1992.
- Is Luzerne County's third largest library.
- Serves nine municipalities comprising the Dallas and Lake-Lehman school districts, with a population of more than 34,000 people.
- Is assisted in its programs by an army of 42 active volunteers who donated 2,871 hours of service in 1992.
- Will receive state funding of only \$18,000 or 10% of its total operating budget of approximately \$180,000 this year.
- Received 25% of its budget last year from the auction, one of the oldest events of its kind in the Northeast. According to head librarian Martha Wheeler, the auction accounts for the most important part of the library's budget.
- Expects more than 10,000 people to attend the auction, which will offer more than 1,000 items for sale.
- The balance is made up from other fundraising activities, rent from the day care center upstairs and private donations.
- The Back Mountain Memorial Library offers a wide range of services to all age groups, including:
  - Children's programs: story hour, special observances for Children's Book Week in November, a preschool program, a summer reading program for elementary school students, nature videos, children's stories on video and books on cassette that can be read and listened to. The summer reading games has enrolled 200 children this year.
  - Adult programs: books on tape and videos of Public Broadcasting Service (PBS) programs.
  - Community outreach program: in conjunction with the Rotary and Kiwanis clubs, the library operates a loaner service which provides wheelchairs, crutches, canes and other needs for disabled persons free of charge.

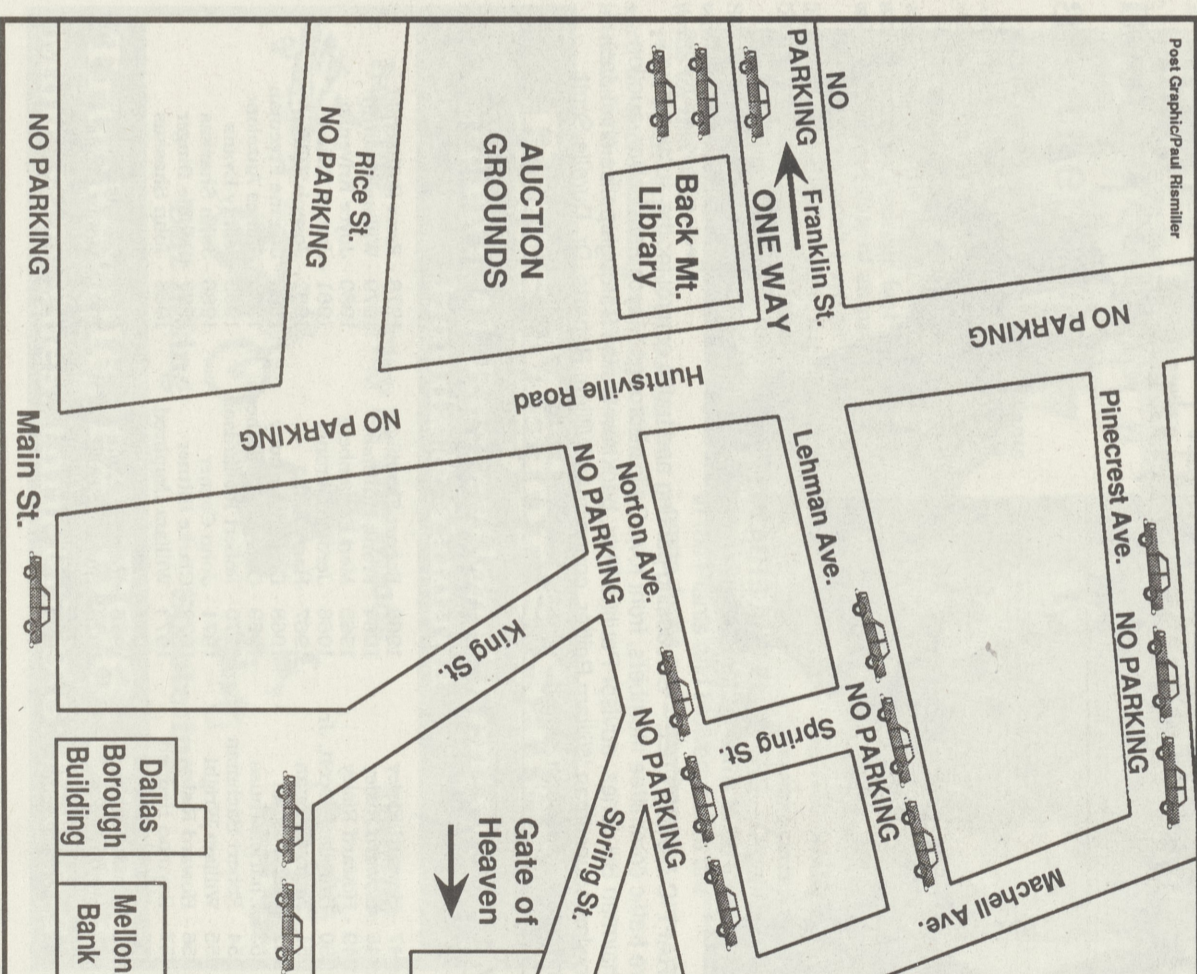
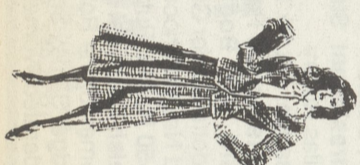

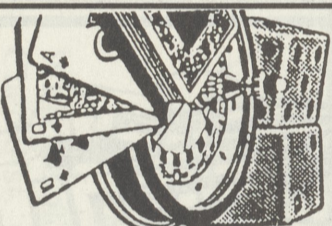
