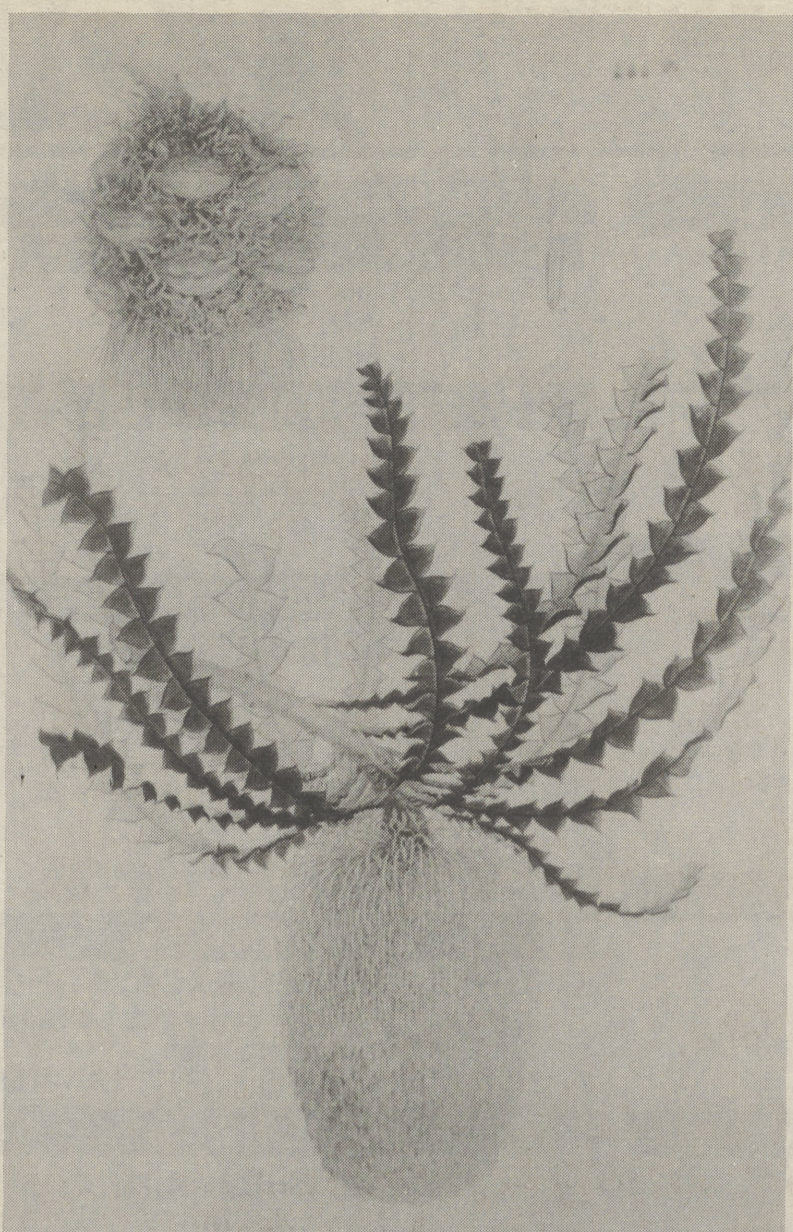
Drawings at Everhart

The work of renowned botanical artist, Ferdinand Bauer are on display at the Everhart Museum now through August 15. Bauer was a member of the crew of the HMS Investigator that, from 1801 to 1805, explored the shores and inlets of what was then a mysterious new continent - Australia. The artist made thousands of drawings of natural history subjects that are remarkable for their extraordinary exactness and minute detail.

Bauer not only captures the grace and beauty of each unique plant, he literally takes us into the plant, revealing the smallest details. It was as though he had taken his cue from the recent invention of the microscope when he turned his artist's eye on the wonders of this new world. This exhibition includes 21 limited edition prints reproduced from the colored drawings Bauer made of Australian plants. Each of the prints were selected to depict the rich diversity of interesting plants from different parts of Australia.

The show is presented by Blair-Murrah, a museum service organization that provides a wide range of historical, cultural, education and contemporary exhibitions throughout the world.
